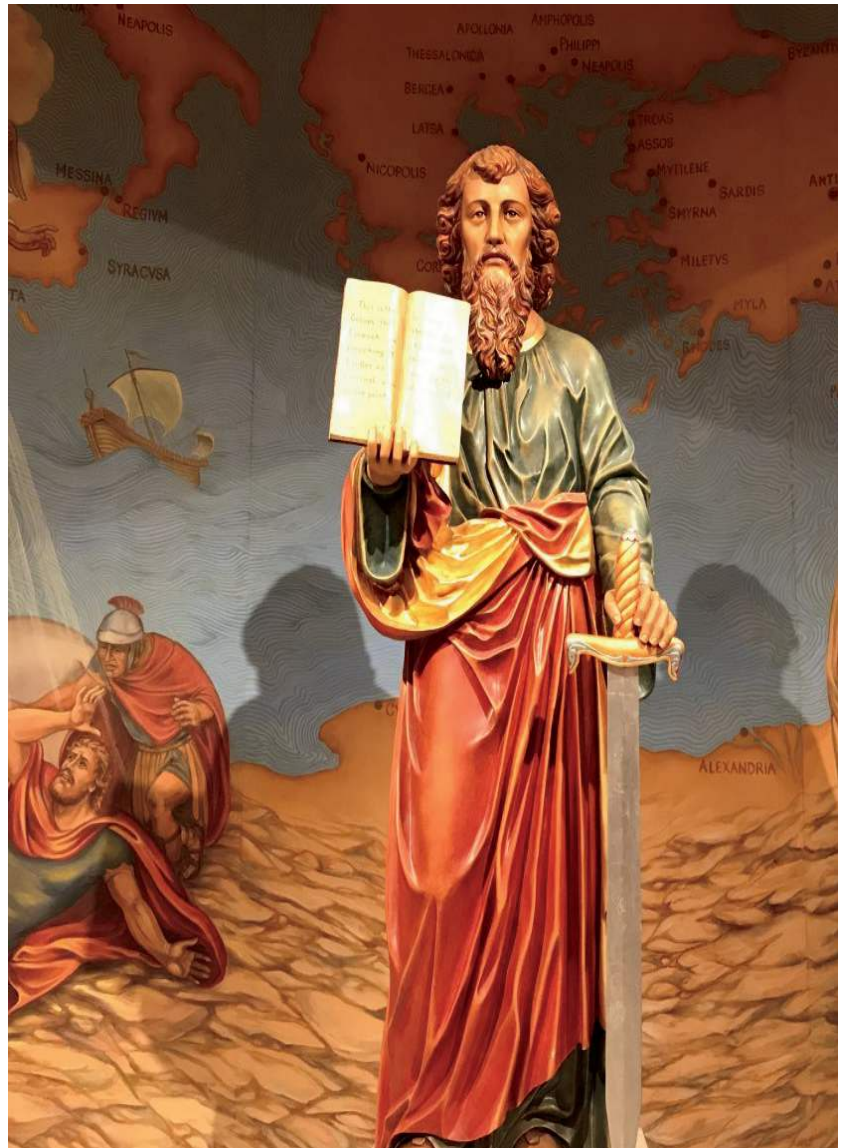

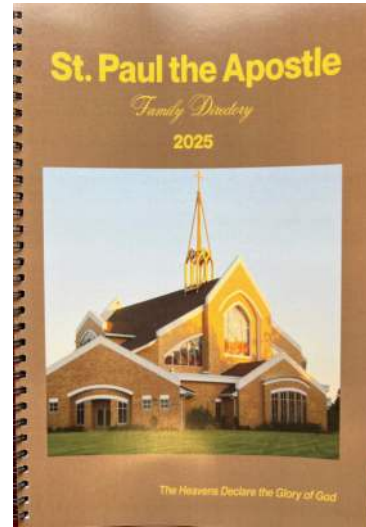

Background on the Gospel Reading

The readings for the last few Sundays have been about the Resurrection, but today's Gospel takes us back in time to an event in Jesus' life before his Passion. Jesus tells his disciples that he is going to prepare a place for them in his Father's house. He promises that where he is going, his disciples will be able to follow. Thomas, who will later doubt the disciples' reports that they have seen the Risen Lord, contradicts Jesus by saying that the disciples don't know where Jesus is going or how to get there. Jesus explains that he himself is the way, the truth, and the life. In knowing and loving Jesus, the disciples now love God the Father. **Philip** then makes a request that challenges Jesus' words. Philip wants Jesus to show the Father to the disciples. Recall that Jesus has just told his disciples, "If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him." As a good teacher, Jesus responds to Philip by repeating and elaborating on what he has just told the disciples: they have seen and known Jesus, so they have seen and known the Father. Then Jesus offers another reassurance about his departure: because of faith in God and in Jesus, the disciples will do the work that Jesus has done and more.

The connection between Jesus and his Father, between Jesus' work and the work of the Father, is made clear in today's Gospel. Jesus is in the Father, and God the Father is in Jesus. As God spoke his name to Moses, "I am," so too Jesus speaks his name to his disciples: "I am the way and the truth and the life."

Antecedentes de la Lectura del Evangelio

Las lecturas de los últimos domingos han tratado sobre la Resurrección, pero el Evangelio de hoy nos lleva de nuevo en el tiempo a un acontecimiento en la vida de Jesús antes de su Pasión. Jesús dice a sus discípulos que va a prepararles un lugar en la casa de su Padre. Les promete que adonde él va, sus discípulos podrán seguirlo. Tomás, quien más tarde dudará del testimonio de los discípulos que han visto al Señor resucitado, contradice a Jesús diciendo que no saben a dónde va ni cómo llegar allí. Jesús le explica que él mismo es el camino, la verdad y la vida. Al conocer y amar a Jesús, los discípulos también aman a Dios Padre. **Luego Felipe** hace una petición que pone a prueba las palabras de Jesús: quiere que les muestre al Padre. Recordemos que Jesús acaba de decirles: «Si me conocen a mí, también conocerán a mi Padre. Desde ahora lo conocen y lo han visto». Como buen maestro, Jesús responde repitiendo y ampliando lo que ya les ha dicho: quien lo ha visto y conocido a él, ha visto y conocido al Padre. Después, Jesús ofrece otra seguridad sobre su partida: por la fe en Dios y en él, los discípulos realizarán las obras que él ha hecho y aún mayores.

La conexión entre Jesús y su Padre, entre la obra de Jesús y la obra del Padre, queda clara en el Evangelio de hoy. Jesús está en el Padre y Dios Padre está en Jesús. Así como Dios reveló su nombre a Moisés, «Yo soy», también Jesús revela su identidad a sus discípulos: «Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida».

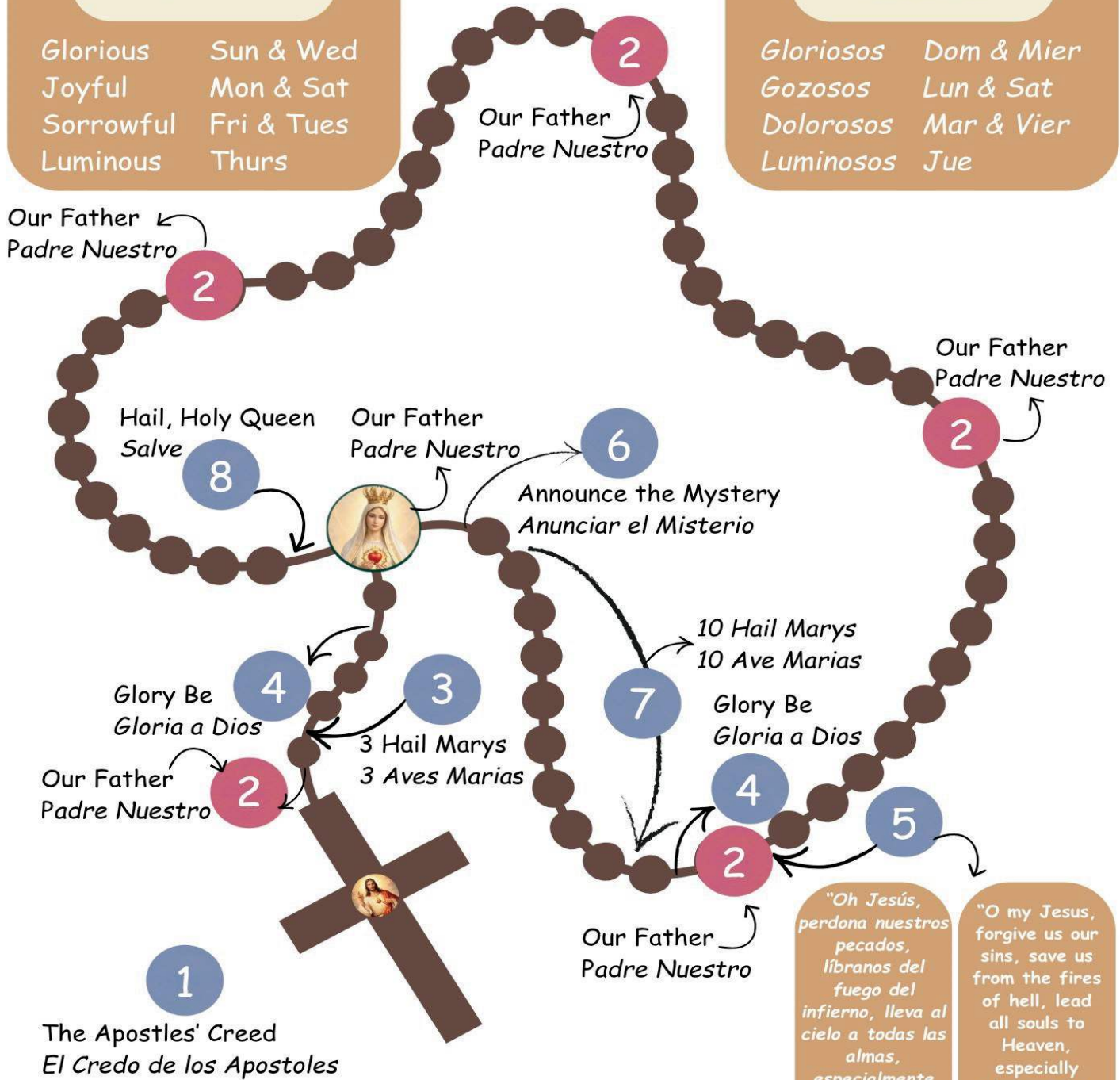

The Principles of Catholic Social Justice

- Dignity of the Human Person:** Human life is sacred; each person is made in the image of God. This is the foundation of all Catholic Social Justice teaching.
- The Common Good and Community:** To "love your neighbor" has individual and broad social commitments. Everyone has a responsibility to contribute to the common good.
- Preferential Option for the Poor and Vulnerable:** The moral test of a society is how it treats its most vulnerable members. The poor have the most urgent moral claim on the conscience of a nation.
- Rights and Responsibilities:** Every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to the things required for human decency, including food, shelter, clothing, employment, health care, and education. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities. We are called to work globally for Justice.
- Subsidiarity and the Role of Government:** The principle of subsidiarity holds that the functions of government should be performed by and at the level as close as possible to and by the people most affected. Only when needs cannot be met adequately is a higher level of government required to provide help for the common good. Authentic development must be full, human development as a requirement for human dignity.
- Economic Justice: The economy must serve people, not the other way around.** Workers have a right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to safe working conditions, and a right to organize. Rights to economic initiatives and private property have limits. Catholic teaching opposes amassing excessive wealth when others lack the basic necessities of life.
- Stewardship of God's Creation:** How we treat the environment is a sign of our respect for our Creator. The goods of the earth are gifts from God and are intended by God for the benefit of everyone. We have a responsibility to care for these goods as stewards, not as consumers.
- Promotion of Peace and Disarmament:** Peace is the fruit of justice and is dependent upon right order among human beings. Peace is a positive, action-oriented concept. "Peace is not just the absence of war. It involves mutual respect and confidence between peoples and nations. It involves collaboration and binding agreements." (Pope John Paul II)
