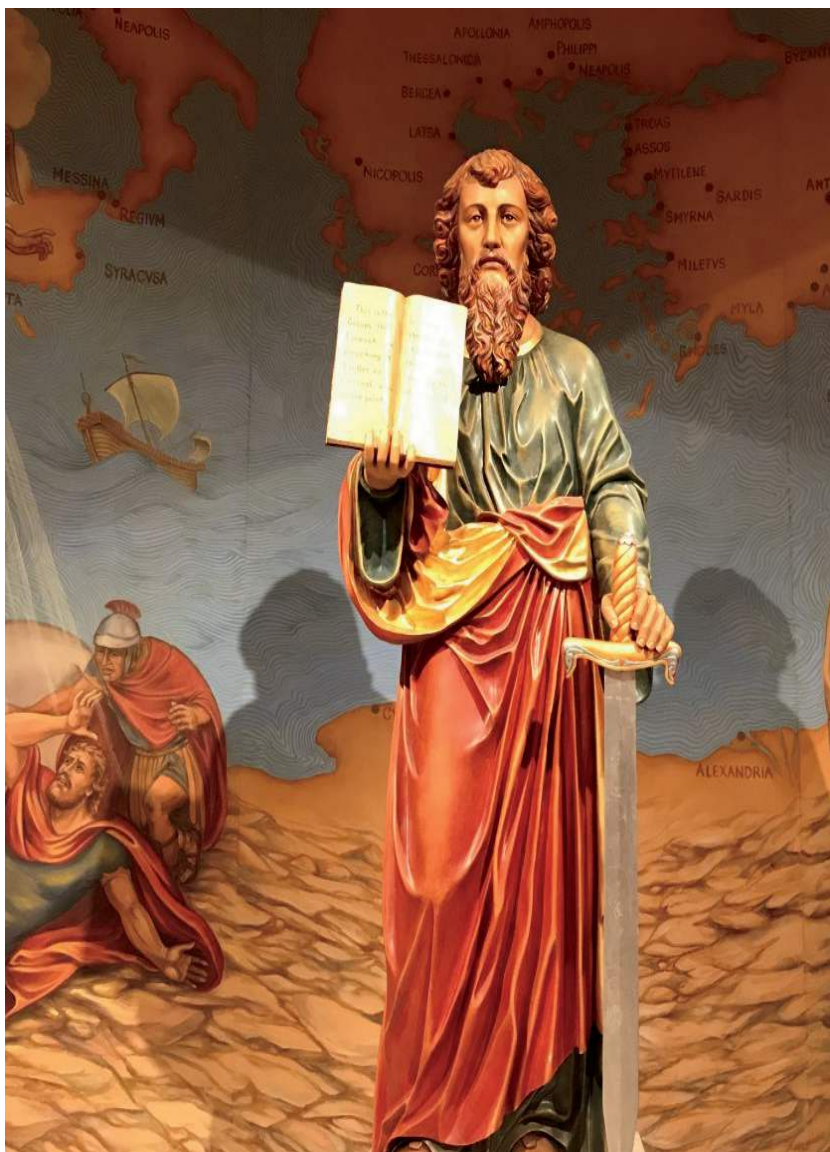

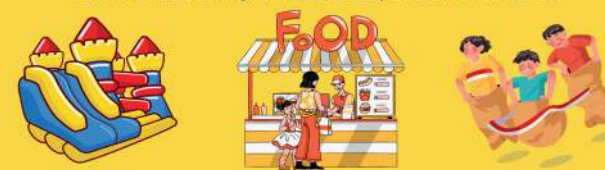

Background on the Gospel Reading

In today's Gospel, Jesus shares his mission to proclaim the kingdom of heaven with his disciples. The signs of the kingdom's presence consist of the work that Jesus has already been doing: the sick are cured, lepers are cleansed, demons are driven out, and the dead are raised to life. The disciples are sent to continue doing the work that Jesus has begun. This is a moment of transition in Matthew's Gospel. The focus has shifted from the ministry of Jesus to the work of the community that he has inaugurated. More than any other Gospel, Matthew's Gospel elaborates on the work of the Church, which is to continue after Jesus' death and resurrection. **Matthew lists** the names of the twelve disciples, as do Mark and Luke. Matthew also uses the word *apostle* when referring to the Twelve. The word *apostle* means "one who is sent." In this context, Matthew is calling attention to the mission that the twelve disciples are being given. They are sent by Jesus to proclaim the kingdom of heaven in word and deed.

As Jesus sent his disciples to continue his work and mission, so too the Church is sent by Jesus. The Church is his continuing presence on earth. Every member of the Church is sent by Jesus to contribute to this mission.



Antecedentes de la Lectura del Evangelio

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús comparte con sus discípulos su misión de proclamar el Reino de los Cielos. Las señales de la presencia del Reino consisten en las obras que Jesús ya venía realizando: los enfermos son curados, los leprosos son limpiados, los demonios son expulsados y los muertos vuelven a la vida. Los discípulos son

enviados a continuar la obra que Jesús ha comenzado. Este es un momento de transición en el Evangelio de Mateo. El enfoque pasa del ministerio de Jesús a la obra de la comunidad que Él ha inaugurado. Más que cualquier otro Evangelio, el Evangelio de Mateo desarrolla la misión de la Iglesia, la cual debe continuar después de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús.

*Mateo enumera los nombres de los doce discípulos, al igual que Marcos y Lucas. Mateo también utiliza la palabra **apóstol** al referirse a los Doce. La palabra **apóstol** significa "uno que es enviado". En este contexto, Mateo llama la atención sobre la misión que se les encomienda a los doce discípulos. Son enviados por Jesús para proclamar el Reino de los Cielos con palabras y obras.*

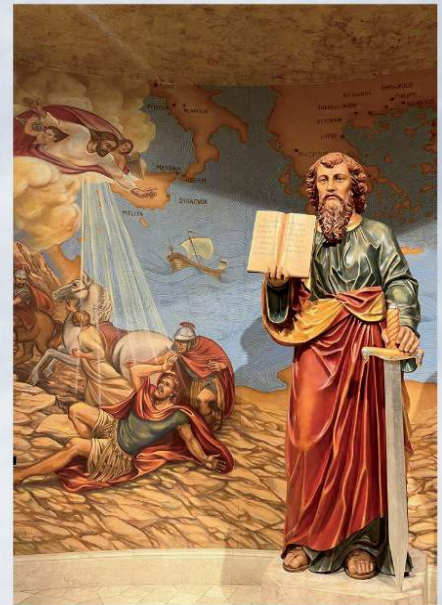

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The Principles of Catholic Social Justice

- Dignity of the Human Person:** Human life is sacred; each person is made in the image of God. This is the foundation of all Catholic Social Justice teaching.
- The Common Good and Community:** To "love your neighbor" has individual and broad social commitments. Everyone has a responsibility to contribute to the common good.
- Preferential Option for the Poor and Vulnerable:** The moral test of a society is how it treats its most vulnerable members. The poor have the most urgent moral claim on the conscience of a nation.
- Rights and Responsibilities:** Every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to the things required for human decency, including food, shelter, clothing, employment, health care, and education. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities. We are called to work globally for justice.
- Subsidiarity and the Role of Government:** The principle of subsidiarity holds that the functions of government should be performed by and at the level as close as possible to and by the people most affected. Only when needs cannot be met adequately is a higher level of government required to provide help for the common good. Authentic development must be full, human development as a requirement for human dignity.
- Economic Justice:** The economy must serve people, not the other way around. Workers have a right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to safe working conditions, and a right to organize. Rights to economic initiatives and private property have limits. Catholic teaching opposes amassing excessive wealth when others lack the basic necessities of life.
- Stewardship of God's Creation:** How we treat the environment is a sign of our respect for our Creator. The goods of the earth are gifts from God and are intended by God for the benefit of everyone. We have a responsibility to care for these goods as stewards, not as consumers.
- Promotion of Peace and Disarmament:** Peace is the fruit of justice and is dependent upon right order among human beings. Peace is a positive, action-oriented concept. "Peace is not just the absence of war. It involves mutual respect and confidence between peoples and nations. It involves collaboration and binding agreements." (Pope John Paul II)

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
