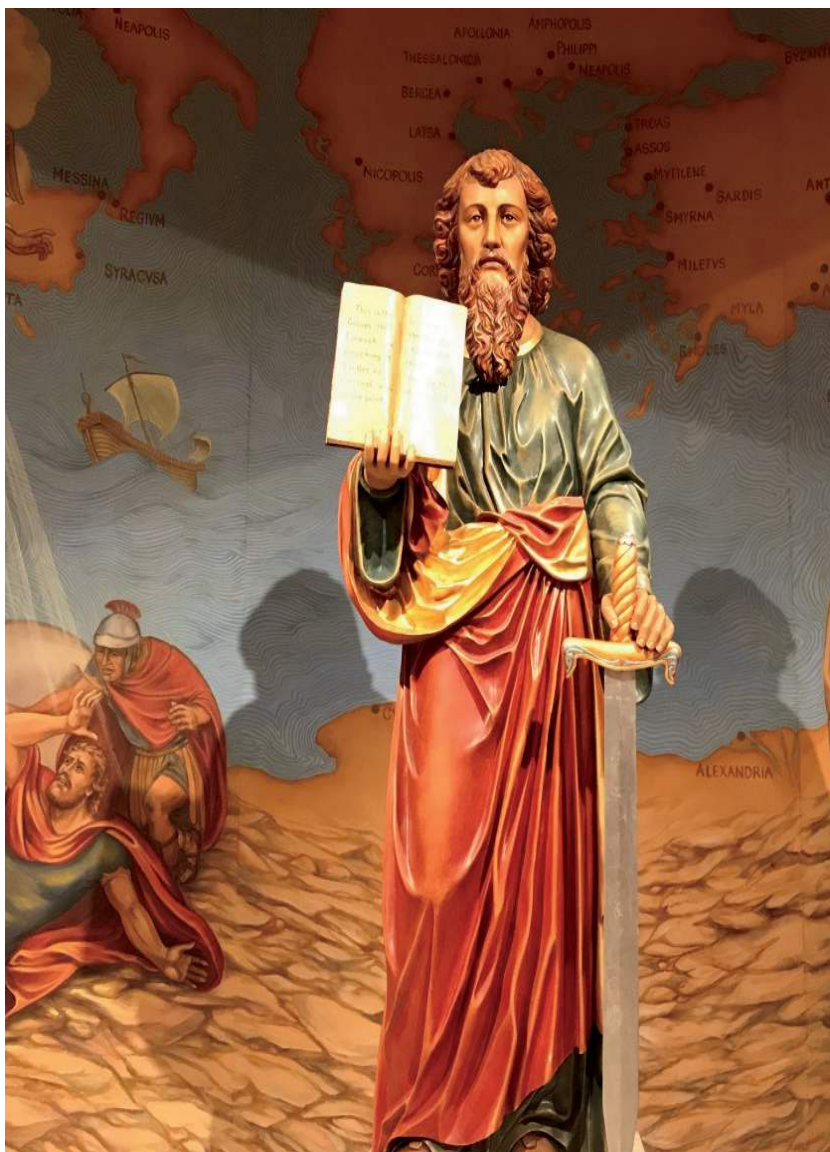

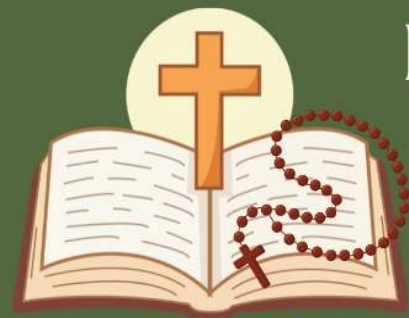

Background on the Gospel Reading

In this week's Gospel, Jesus offers three more short parables. The first two parables describe the great value of the kingdom of heaven. In the first parable, Jesus says that the kingdom of heaven is like a buried treasure that is worth possessing even if it means giving up everything else. In the second parable, Jesus proposes that the kingdom of heaven is like a pearl of great worth for which one will sell everything else to possess. These parables teach us that we are to place everything we value in the service of the pursuit of the Kingdom of God.

The third parable that Jesus proposes in today's Gospel is different from the first two, but it is reminiscent of the parable of the sower heard in last week's Gospel. The kingdom of heaven is compared to fishing with a wide net. After the fish have been collected, the good fish are kept and the bad fish are thrown away; so too, in the final judgment, will the wicked and the righteous be separated.

Today's Gospel concludes with a curious statement about the scribe who understands the kingdom of heaven. Here a metaphor is offered: this scribe is like the head of a household who "brings from his storeroom both the new and the old." The scribes referred to here are experts of Mosaic law. It is possible that Jesus is here instructing the early Christian community on how to proceed in the interpretation of Jewish law with respect to Jesus' "new" teaching. Jesus' teaching about the kingdom of heaven does not replace the Jewish tradition; it interprets it in a different light.

Antecedentes de la Lectura del Evangelio

En el Evangelio de esta semana, Jesús presenta tres parábolas breves más. Las dos primeras describen el inmenso valor del Reino de los Cielos. En la primera, Jesús dice que el Reino de los Cielos es como un tesoro escondido en un campo, tan valioso que vale la pena vender todo lo que se tiene para adquirirlo. En la segunda, compara el Reino con una perla de gran valor, por la cual una persona está dispuesta a vender todo lo que posee para obtenerla. Estas parábolas nos enseñan que debemos poner todo lo que valoramos al servicio de la búsqueda del Reino de Dios.

La tercera parábola es diferente de las dos primeras, pero recuerda la parábola del sembrador que escuchamos en el Evangelio de la semana pasada. En ella, el Reino de los Cielos se compara con una red que se echa al mar y recoge toda clase de peces. Cuando la red se llena, los pescadores separan los peces buenos de los malos: los buenos se guardan y los malos se desechan. Del mismo modo, en el juicio final, los justos serán separados de los malvados.

El Evangelio de hoy concluye con una afirmación interesante acerca del escriba que comprende el Reino de los Cielos. Jesús utiliza una metáfora al decir que ese escriba es como el dueño de una casa que "saca de su tesoro cosas nuevas y cosas antiguas". Los escribas eran expertos en la Ley de Moisés. Es posible que Jesús esté enseñando a la primera comunidad cristiana cómo interpretar la ley judía a la luz de su "nueva" enseñanza. La enseñanza de Jesús sobre el Reino de los Cielos no reemplaza la tradición judía; más bien, la ilumina y la interpreta desde una perspectiva nueva.

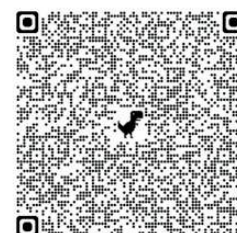

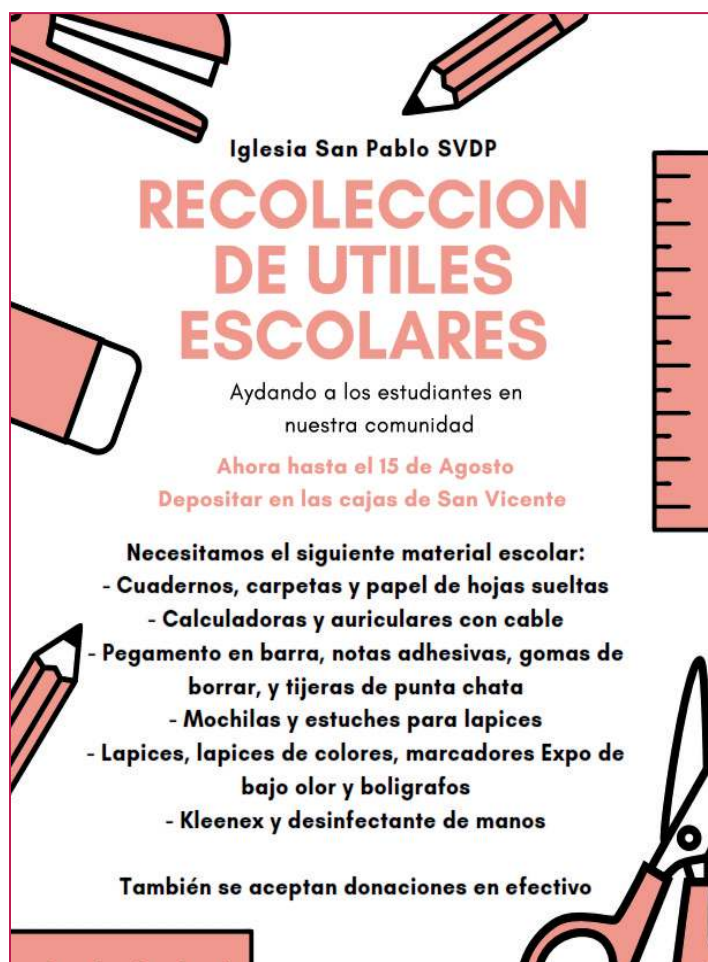

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The Principles of Catholic Social Justice

- 1) **Dignity of the Human Person:** Human life is sacred; each person is made in the image of God. This is the foundation of all Catholic Social Justice teaching.
- 2) **The Common Good and Community:** To "love your neighbor" has individual and broad social commitments. Everyone has a responsibility to contribute to the common good.
- 3) **Preferential Option for the Poor and Vulnerable:** The moral test of a society is how it treats its most vulnerable members. The poor have the most urgent moral claim on the conscience of a nation.
- 4) **Rights and Responsibilities:** Every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to the things required for human decency, including food, shelter, clothing, employment, health care, and education. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities. We are called to work globally for justice.
- 5) **Subsidiarity and the Role of Government:** The principle of subsidiarity holds that the functions of government should be performed by and at the level as close as possible to and by the people most affected. Only when needs cannot be met adequately is a higher level of government required to provide help for the common good. Authentic development must be full, human development as a requirement for human dignity.
- 6) **Economic Justice: The economy must serve people, not the other way around.** Workers have a right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to safe working conditions, and a right to organize. Rights to economic initiatives and private property have limits. Catholic teaching opposes amassing excessive wealth when others lack the basic necessities of life.
- 7) **Stewardship of God's Creation:** How we treat the environment is a sign of our respect for our Creator. The goods of the earth are gifts from God and are intended by God for the benefit of everyone. We have a responsibility to care for these goods as stewards, not as consumers.
- 8) **Promotion of Peace and Disarmament:** Peace is the fruit of justice and is dependent upon right order among human beings. Peace is a positive, action-oriented concept. "Peace is not just the absence of war. It involves mutual respect and confidence between peoples and nations. It involves collaboration and binding agreements." (Pope John Paul II)

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
