

I hope everyone had a safe and enjoyable New Year celebration. I pray that 2015 is a year full of blessings from God and growth in your Christian discipleship.

This coming Thursday, January 8 at 7p in the multipurpose room, the Connected in the Spirit Core Team will be hosting a session as part of our in-house parish evaluation. We have identified and invited members of the

parish to come and participate (to make sure there are some people there!), but all interested parishioners are welcome to come and offer their feedback. We would value and appreciate your important contributions. The more voices heard, the more sound the assessment. We want this to be a true and authentic reflection of St Mary of the Immaculate Conception Parish in Rushville.

The Task Force Session will begin with a brief overview and then break into four task groups. The four task groups will discuss some guiding questions provided by the Archdiocese around the following areas: 1. Sacramental Life of the Parish (Eucharist, other Sacraments, ministries); 2. Evangelization and Catechesis (invite, welcome, catechetical formation, Catholic school, adult faith); 3. Stewardship and Justice (3 "T's", social ministry, outreach, education); 4. Administration (pastor, staffing, councils, commissions, facilities, finances, inter-parish cooperation). This is an important first stage of the overall CIS process.

Other exciting news for the parish, we are going to do a 2015 Parish Pictorial Directory. It's been 5 years since our last one, and the children have grown, we've welcomed new faces, and sadly seen a few move on. We are working with Life Touch, Inc. on this project. Please arrange for your family to get their picture taken. We want it to be as complete as possible. There will be several sign-up sessions after Masses this weekend and on the weekend of January 24-25.




