

Hey Father, did you notice that someone covered the statues in church? Yes, per the permitted practices of the Church. The 5th week of Lent until the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday of the Easter Vigil) is known as Passiontide. It is during these last days of Lent that we are to keep our hearts and souls united to the Lord in His Passion in a special way. The crosses are covered until the end of the celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday. Images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.

So why do we veil statues? Statues are veiled to help us realize what it would be like NOT to have the fruits of the Passion and Resurrection of Jesus. If our Lord had not died and rose from the grave; there would be no saints, no images of the Passion, no images of the Sacred Heart. Because we see them so often, these images become "normal" and taken for granted. We veil them in order to emphasize how good they are. By taking them away for a short while, we appreciate their goodness anew.

The veiling of statues is just one more way we are undergoing a progressive fast during Lent.

- We fast from the *Alleluia* beginning on Ash Wednesday.
- We fast from the *Gloria* during Lent except for Solemnities.
- We fast from viewing the Crucifix and statues at the start of Passiontide.
- We fast from the Sanctus bells and the Church bell from the Gloria of Holy Thursday to the Easter Vigil
- We fast from Holy Water during the Triduum
- Finally, we are deprived of the Lord Himself in the Blessed Sacrament (we process the Eucharist out of the Church at the Holy Thursday Service) and the celebration of Holy Mass is not celebrated on Good Friday (the only day of the year when there is no Mass).

All of this is restored in glorious fashion - solemnly and progressively - during the Easter Vigil. First the statues. Then the Gloria. Then the bells. Then the Alleluia. Then the Holy Water. Finally the Holy Eucharist. So many treasures in the Sacred Liturgy that we come to appreciate more keenly during this Holy Time of year.

<u>First Communion</u>, for sixteen children of St. Mary Parish, will be on Sunday, May 3, 2015 at the 10:00a.m. Mass.


