

FROM The work of the Connected in the Spirit Archdiocesan planning process continues to proceed. The St Mary's Core Team will present the initial 'Preliminary Recommendations' for the St Anne-St Rose-St Elizabeth-St Mary Cohort. This is an opportunity for local parishes to comment on the recommendation prior to sending it to the Archdiocesan Planning Commission. A lot of work and discussion have taken place, and there are several places for joint ministry, programing, and outreach, which will need to happen in our Cohort and parish.

The Cohort Team met Wednesday, April 8 evening at St. Anne Parish. A majority of those present opted for a plan to be submitted to the Archdiocese, which would link St. Ann, St. Elizabeth, and St. Rose, under one priest-pastor. The language as approved by the majority (but not all) reads:

Link the Henry County and Western Wayne County parishes together under one priest-pastor. St. Elizabeth retains two weekend Masses while St. Anne and St. Rose each have one weekend Mass. Understanding is that staff would be hired to serve the functions of pastoral associate, three business managers, and shared religious education, and youth ministry personnel for the linked parishes. Local parish secretarial support and lay member responsibilities would continue. St. Mary continues, as before, with its personal pastor.

Linked parishes maintain their individual canonical status, finances, councils and committees, and buildings, while sharing a single priest as pastor over the two or more linked parishes. Various ministries and administrative roles may be handled by joint staff members between the linked parishes. The specifics of the linkage would evolve with time, but some of the primary adjustments would be worked out during the initial implementation phase. St Mary's, while not sharing a priest or pastor with our neighbors to the north, will still partner with those parishes to share ministries and coordinate activities. These details too will be formalized as the process continues. The whole of this process is to be substantially done by October, after which the Archbishop will make a final decision on recommended parish arrangements and implementation plans. St Mary, Pray for us. ~ Fr. Gries
