

**Baptism** 

The Lord is truly risen, Alleluia!

To Him be glory and power for all the ages of eternity, alleluia, alleluia!

How well do you and your family live out your Catholic Christian Faith at home, in the workplace, at school, on the court? It has been asked, "If you were put on trial for being a Christian, would there be sufficient evidence to convict you?" As we know, salvation is by faith, but from our faith flows action. Our faith finds expression in our deeds, attitudes, and interactions with others. So, how well do you do?

I ask this in light of the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles. First, we should notice it is called "Acts" of the Apostles not "words" of the Apostles or "pious thoughts on Sunday morning in the relative safety of the church building where most people believe like me" of the Apostles. No, it is called the Acts of the Apostles. And on account of those actions, Peter and the Apostles are questioned by the Sanhedrin (the same Sanhedrin which only days or weeks before had condemned Jesus Christ to the Cross). They are questioned about their preaching, teaching, and healing in the name of Jesus Christ. Their public actions and witness were sufficient to cause them to be arrested and brought before the Sanhedrin. There, they were questioned and tried. Peter boldly now (no longer cowering in the shadows to deny Jesus in the courtyard) proclaims, "We must obey God rather than men" (Acts 5:29). Many on the Sanhedrin were enraged and wanted to kill Peter and the others. The disciples were spared for the time, but were instructed not to act in Jesus' name. Peter and the disciples refused. They obeyed their well-formed consciences. They obeyed God. They continued to act, to preach, to teach, to heal, to reach out, to forgive, and to extend mercy in their daily, Christian lives.

If the Resurrection of Jesus means something to you, if it has truly touched you, if it has inspired you, if it has given you hope in salvation and eternal life, why would you not show that joy and love and peace in your actions, attitudes, and interactions with others. "Go witness to these things" (Acts 5:32)
