Our Parish is beginning a Capital Campaign entitled: *Preserving Our Heritage – Honoring 150 Years, Preparing for Many More*. This campaign will largely address the central space of our parish 150th year of Catholic Education at St Mary of the Immaculate Conception Parish, Rushville. The overall goal will be \$900,000. Please mark your calendars now for Sunday, January 28,2018 at the 10a Mass. **Archbishop Charles C. Thompson** will preside at and preach this Mass to begin *Catholic Schools Week* and to recognize the 150th Anniversary of Catholic Education in our parish. There will be a reception for the whole parish to meet the Archbishop and celebrate the 150th immediately following the 10a Mass in the parish gym.



- Q: Father, I need to go to a funeral Mass Saturday morning and I want to go to the Saturday night 5:30p Mass for my Sunday duty to God. May I receive Holy Communion at both Masses in the same day?
- A: Yes, per Canon 917. A person may receive the Most Holy Eucharist up to two (2) times in the same day provided the second time is in the context of the Eucharistic celebration itself (i.e., Mass) and also provided the person receiving is in the State of Grace (not aware of any unconfessed and unabsolved mortal sins), which is *always* necessary for the reception of the Most Holy Eucharist even once.
- Q: Father, have you noticed you sometimes repeat yourself week to week in your pastoral notes? You will make similar comments and announcements a couple of weeks in a row.
- A: Well, yes, I do know that. It is intentional. I know that a few of our parish families do not manage to attend Mass here at St Mary, Rushville every single weekend. And certain topics, events, and parish happenings are just so important to our communal Church life that everyone needs to see and hear it.
- Q: Father, I happen to be one of those who sometimes has to attend Mass in another town? I'm one who happens to be elderly and when weather is bad or I'm not feeling well needs to legitimately stay home. How would I see the bulletin when I can dutifully attend the Most Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on Saturday or Sunday?


