From the Pastor's Desk: Reflection: Matthew 21, 33-43



This parable still speaks to us today. It richly
conveys some important truths about God
and the way he deals with his people. First, it
tells us of God's generosity and trust. The
vineyard is well equipped with everything the
tenants need. The owner went away and left
the vineyard in the hands of the tenants.

God likewise trusts us enough to give us freedom to run life as we
choose. This parable also tells us of God's patience and justice. Not
once, but many times he forgives the tenants their debt's.

The Lord blesses his people today with the gift of his kingdom. And
he promises that we will bear fruit if we abide in him. He entrusts his
gifts and grace to each of us and he gives us work to do in his vine-
yard, the body of Christ. He promises that our labor will not be in
vain if we persevere with faith to the end.

Jesus knew he would be rejected and be killed, but he also knew
that would not be the end. After rejection would come glory, the glo-
ry of resurrection and ascension to the right hand of the Father.

Thank you, Lord Jesus Christ, for all the benefits which you have
given us, for all the pains and insults which you have borne for us. O
most merciful redeemer, friend and brother, may we know you more
clearly, love you more dearly, and follow you more nearly for you
own sake.
