Bless him this day with Your strength and holy power that he may continue to be a sign of You, our God, and a priestly parent to our family.


May we who have the honor of bearing his family name do so with great pride.

...It's Time to Come Back to Mass...



Archbishop Rozanski announced that the dispensation from the obligation to participate in person at Sunday Eucharist, which is inherent to observing the 4th Commandment of the Decalogue, will be lifted as of July 1st. Thereafter, only parishioners who are sick, who are homebound, who are immunocompromised and/or who are gravely concerned for their health will retain the dispensation from the obligation to participate in Eucharist in person, which has always been the case even in normal times. All parishioners are asked to prayerfully consider ways that you may invite your family, friends, and neighbors to acknowledge that the time to return to Sunday Mass is now.

Live-streaming of Sunday Mass will be discontinued as of July 1st until we have returned to worship in our church building. We are installing a built-in video system that will allow us to livestream worship. When live-streaming resumes after we return to worship in our church building, it will be made available to our homebound and infirm parishioners and those otherwise impeded from being present for Mass in person via a special access viewing code.

...Church completion update... The construction company has contracted a cleaning company to thoroughly clean all areas that have been affected by construction. Pews are scheduled to arrive and installation of them is scheduled to begin this coming week. Other wooden furnishings will be delivered at the same time. All metalwork appointments (tabernacle, candle stands, etc.) are slated to ship June 21st. We are now waiting on definitive delivery date for stone appointments (altar, ambo, tabernacle pedestal). We are working diligently to have the church usable to accommodate a wedding scheduled for July 10th. Organ installation will begin at the outset of August and will be done in stages that will take approximately two months to complete. We will resume worship in church as soon as it is sufficiently usable. Please remember to mark your calendar for our Rededication and 40th Anniversary Celebration and the Pastoral Visit of Archbishop Rozanski on Sunday, August 22nd, for 11:30 Mass with a large outdoor bash (food and band) immediately following!



Safe Environment

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**.

Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required to register in the new system and complete the steps outlined below. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. Those new to service must register in Prevent and Protect STL prior to employment or volunteering. Those currently in service must register in the new system in order to remain in compliance with Safe Environment.

For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to the new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, employees and volunteers will:

- 1. Register for an updated background screening. Screenings will automatically be updated every three months.
- 2. View two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct
- 3. Agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct
- 4. An online Protecting God's Children refresher will be required every three years.

Complete your personal information. Please enter your **legal first name** for the purposes of the background screening. Background screenings will automatically be updated every three months.

Create a username, password and password clue. Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT.

You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a Protecting God's Children workshop*, view two online training modules, and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct.

*If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and/or ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop. If, for some reason, it does not match your previous training to this account and you are prompted to register for a class, please register for December 31, 2020 "PREVIOUSLY ATTENDED-DATE NOT LISTED"

The correct training record will be applied to your account by the Office of Child and Youth Protection.

User may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
