

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This past week many of our youth and a few of our adults received an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon their lives in the sacrament of Confirmation. Many of us will be tempted to do one of two things - to think of confirmation as a Catholic graduation or as something that we have chosen. While our actions are important and taking a bold new step forward against temptation and indifference is certainly part of the sacrament, it is not at the heart of Confirmation. Confirmation is first and foremost the action of the Holy Spirit, a prayer, during which God confirms and deepens what He has done in our lives. We open our hearts and God, in the person of the Holy Spirit, pours in. Take a look at the way the sacrament is given - an imposition of hands. Pope Benedict reminds us that this is a protective gesture, "The Lord takes responsibility for me. He does not spare me the wind and the weather, but he protects me from real evil." I find this to be helpful because it reminds me that it does not all depend on me. God steps in, starts and then does most of the work.
