






Our parish is in need of singers and musicians to help provide music for our Masses.

As stated in the following letter there are 3 ways to receive "Shareback Money" If you have not donated to the Annual Appeal there is still time for the current year of 2022/2023. The campaign ends on March 31.

Congratulations! Enclosed you will find your rebate AKA "shareback" check from the 2021/22 Diocesan Annual Appeal (DAA). This is not the current campaign. This is for the previous year's campaign.

We are very proud and appreciative of your efforts. These funds are unrestricted funds to be used in your parish as you and your parish/finance council see fit. Continued best wishes.

If you have not reached all three "shareback" milestones yet in the current 2022/23 campaign....there is still time! The campaign ends on March 31.

This year we are offering three (3) Shareback opportunities:

- 1) When a parish meets their DAA Paid Goal they earn 10% of the goal in the form of a rebate or "share back" to the parish.
- 2) When a parish goes over their DAA Paid Goal they earn 50% of the surplus in the form of a rebate or "shareback" to the parish.
- 3) When a parish hits its DAA Participation Goal, (50% of registered parishioners for most parishes) they receive 3% of the goal in the form of a rebate or "share back" to the parish.

Parishes are eligible to earn all three sharebacks in a given year, and many often do earn all three. Jill and I would be happy to help you create a plan to meet/exceed our 2022-23 goals. Call us if we can be of assistance.
