

God has loved you from all eternity and longs for a close relationship with you. In Scripture, He says, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you" (Jer. 1:5).



Scripture tells us that God fashioned human life in His image and likeness as the crown of all creation—but He didn't stop there. His love for us was so great that He became human, further elevating the dignity of our humanity. Jesus was conceived in the womb of the Blessed Mother and, like each one of us, grew and developed as a preborn child beneath the shelter of His mother's heart.

This simultaneously reveals the undeniable humanity of preborn children and the intrinsic value of all human life. Abortion tragically rejects these truths, ending the life of a child and harming those involved in a variety of ways. Like the Blessed Mother, we are called to welcome, protect, and nurture the gift of new life from its first and most fragile moments. Following Jesus means caring for and protecting those who are most vulnerable and helping others to do the same. May each of us work to ensure life is protected and cherished in our laws and in our hearts.




