



Pastor's Page

A Grateful Heart-Thanksgiving Reflection.

In the Bible, thanksgiving means devotion, sacrifice, praise, or an offering. Thanksgiving is to glorify God as an act of worship, giving thanks for all things as part of God's providence.

We give thanks, first and foremost, because it is God's will that we do so. God's Word is replete with exhortations to thanksgiving, both in the Old and New Testaments, and especially in the Psalms:

1 Thessalonians 5:18 – In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:6 – Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God Psalm 118:1Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, his mercy endures forever.

I will give to the Lord the thanks due to his righteousness, and I will sing praise to the name of the Lord, the Most High. (Psalm 7:17)

By practicing an attitude of thanksgiving in our daily lives, believers follow the model set by Jesus himself, who expressed gratitude to the Father throughout His life and ministry (Matthew 26:27; Mark 14:23; Luke 22:17–19; 1 Corinthians 11:24). It is for this reason that the Eucharist begins with a prayer of Thanksgiving, after the example of Jesus at the Last Supper.

As Pope Francis has remarked:

Gratitude is always a powerful weapon. Only if we are able to contemplate and feel genuine gratitude for all those ways we have experienced God's love, generosity, solidarity and trust, as well as his forgiveness, patience, forbearance and compassion, will we allow the Spirit to grant us the freshness that can renew... our life and mission. Like Peter on the morning of the miraculous draught of fishes, may we let the recognition of all the blessings we have received awaken in us the amazement and gratitude that can enable us to say: 'Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man' (Luke 5:8). Only then to hear the Lord repeat his summons: 'Do not be afraid; from now on you will be fishers of men' (Luke 5:10). 'For his mercy endures forever.'

Thanksgiving Day, is a day to cherish family, food, and faith. We gather together around the table to celebrate all that life has to offer; we share with each other and with God. This sharing calls us to participate in the delight of God's creation, both in the food prepared, but more importantly with one another. It is the one holiday where we are all willing to travel and gather together around the table.

Thanksgiving is also a time to share blessings with those who are not around the table, too. It calls us not only to share Christ with one another, but to be Christ with the less fortunate around us. Gratitude is demonstrated best through action and service, such as donating to a local food drive. You can also engage in acts of kindness by giving a neighbor a helping hand or in sacrificing small things for your family.

PRAYER:

Lord God, we gather around this table to humbly thank You for all that You have given us this past year – not just what is on this table, but who is sitting around this table. Thank you for life and laughter, health and happiness, relationships and memories. Thank you, too, for the lessons learned and the tears we've cried because of Your ability to grow us through them.

Thank You for Your comfort and presence in light of good days and bad. Thank You for what we have now, what we had yesterday, and what You will continue to give tomorrow. Let us never take that for granted, but to always be grateful for every good and perfect gift that comes from You. May we have hearts full of thanksgiving today and every day of our lives. We pray this through Christ our Lord. Amen.


