

Reflections for Divine Mercy Sunday

Divine Mercy Sunday, the first Sunday after Easter, is a day to reflect on God's boundless love and forgiveness, celebrating the "floodgates of mercy" opened to all. It's an opportunity to trust in God, express repentance, and receive His graces. The day encourages us to deepen our devotion to Jesus' merciful heart and to actively extend that mercy to others.

In the year 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska and added the Feast of Divine Mercy to the Church's official calendar. Saint Faustina, who died in 1938, was a member of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Krakow, Poland. She came from a simple and poor family of farmers, had only three years of rudimentary education, and performed the humblest of tasks in her convent. But she also was a mystic who was privileged to have many private revelations from our Lord. In obedience to her superior and spiritual director, she recorded these private revelations in six notebooks. Those notebooks are known today under the title: *Divine Mercy in My Soul: Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*. The messages contained within her diary present profound communications from God for our day and age.

Themes for Divine Mercy Sunday Year C

Divine Mercy Sunday Year C celebrates God's infinite mercy and forgiveness. The readings highlight themes of faith, healing, and the importance of believing in Christ's resurrection.

- **God's Healing Power:** In Acts 5:12-16, the apostles perform many signs and wonders, showing God's healing power. This reflects how God's mercy brings physical and spiritual healing.
- **Faith in Jesus:** The Gospel of John 20:19-31 recounts Jesus appearing to Thomas,

- **Peace from Christ:** Jesus says, “Peace be with you,” when He appears to the disciples. This peace comes from His mercy and forgiveness, calming our fears and doubts.
- **Witness to Christ:** Revelation 1:9-11A, 12-13, 17-19 speaks of John witnessing Christ’s glory. We are called to be witnesses of Christ’s mercy in the world.
- **Forgiveness of Sins:** Jesus gives the apostles the power to forgive sins, emphasizing the mercy available through the Church. Confession is a way to experience God’s forgiveness and mercy.
- **Thomas’s Declaration:** Thomas’s declaration, “My Lord and my God,” shows a personal encounter with the risen Christ. It encourages us to deepen our own faith and trust in Jesus.

- **God's Unconditional Love:**

Divine Mercy is the manifestation of God's love and compassion, extending to all, even those who feel most distant from Him.

- **Action and Compassion:**

It's not just about receiving mercy but also about actively showing mercy and compassion to others, embodying the love of God in our daily lives.

Divine Mercy Sunday is a reminder of God’s endless mercy and love for us. The themes encourage us to trust in Jesus, seek His forgiveness, and share His peace with others.

As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, ponder the profound significance of this new form of devotion for the Church and world today. We need God’s abundant Divine Mercy to flow from the gates of Heaven upon us more than ever. Only in Heaven will we understand the full depths of God’s Mercy. For now, we must trust all that He has revealed through his humble servant Saint Faustina and respond to the requests He has given to us through her. Commit yourself to the various ways God has called us to call upon His Mercy and do so with as much vigor and devotion you can offer Him.

Prayer: *You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us (#1319). Jesus, I trust in You.*
