



Pastor's Page

God is Good All the Time
All the Time God is Good



Fourth Sunday of Easter

Fourth Sunday of Easter, is commonly known as ‘Good Shepherd Sunday’ (because the Gospel is taken from Jesus’ teaching in chapter 10 of John’s Gospel about himself as the Good Shepherd). But it is also known as ‘Vocation Sunday’ because on this day we pray especially that more may answer the call to serve the Church in a special way (as did Paul and Barnabas), particularly as pastors and religious.

The readings focus on Jesus as the Good Shepherd and how His followers are called to listen and follow Him. It help us understand our relationship with Jesus, the Good Shepherd. They also encourage us to listen, follow, and remain faithful to Him.

- **Jesus as Shepherd:** Jesus calls Himself the Good Shepherd who knows His sheep. This shows His care and protection for us.
- **Listening to Jesus:** Jesus says His sheep hear His voice. We are called to listen to His teachings and follow His guidance.
- **Salvation for All:** In Revelation, a great multitude stands before God. This emphasizes that salvation is offered to everyone.
- **Faithful Witnesses:** Paul and Barnabas speak boldly about Jesus in Acts. They show us the importance of spreading the Good News.
- **Endurance in Faith:** The Book of Revelation speaks of those who have come out of great tribulation. This encourages us to stay faithful despite challenges.

We may be less familiar with the metaphors of sheep and shepherd than those to whom Jesus spoke. The image of Jesus as Good Shepherd and the community of followers as his sheep has endured over the centuries as a primary image in our faith tradition. Its power to describe the relationship between Jesus and his followers transcends direct experience with sheep. The image speaks to us about the protection, security, and care that shepherds represent for their sheep.

The Gospel speaks powerfully about the familiarity and intimacy between Jesus and his disciples, expressed as recognizing and knowing another's voice. Today's Gospel also speaks to the relationship between Jesus and the Father. In the Gospel of John, Jesus identifies so closely with the Father that he tells us that they are one—not just close, but actually one. To know Jesus is to know the Father. Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. Our relationship with Jesus is an invitation to share in the life of God.

Indeed we all act like sheep on many occasions, when it comes to the things that concern our spiritual welfare. We often ramble off from the flock to nibble at little bits of forbidden pasture. However, we have a Shepherd who understands us, one whose patience and love are infinite. He is always ready to go after us when we stray too far; his voice is constantly reaching out to us in missions, retreats, sicknesses, crosses and other various ways. How many times have we already felt his loving grace calling and helping us back to the safety of his fold?


