

Pastor's Page

God is Good All the Time
All the Time God is Good



Quote:

Although the Eucharist is celebrated solemnly every day, we deem it fitting that at least once a year it be celebrated with greater honor and a solemn commemoration. Indeed we grasp the other things we commemorate with our spirit and our mind, but this does not mean that we obtain their real presence. On the contrary, in this sacramental commemoration of Christ, even though in a different form, Jesus Christ is present with us in his own substance. While He was about to ascend into Heaven he said "And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Matthew 28:20) From the papal decree instituting the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, Pope Urban IV

Reflection: Of the greatest and most valuable treasures one could obtain in this world, nothing is more precious, more sacred, and more valuable than the Most Holy Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, our Sovereign and Eucharistic Lord. Millions, billions, or even hundreds of trillions of dollars do not come close to the infinite value and transforming power of the Body and Blood of Christ. No amount of earthly wealth can buy happiness, but the Eucharist bestows it freely. No amount of money can purchase Heaven, but the Eucharist transforms you into a member of the Body of Christ Whom you consume, leading you to Heaven. At the end of our lives, when we stand before the Just Judge, we will realize the transforming power of this Gift. Those who adored Him and received Him faithfully in Communion will be forever grateful they did.

Human dignity demands that we show respect to one another, reverencing the presence of God in each person as a living tabernacle of the Lord. However, we do not bow down before God's presence in others, nor do we kneel before them in adoration and worship. In this world, the only One Whom we worship and adore, in hidden yet physical form, is our Lord Who is fully present in the Eucharist. The Eucharist is not only a fraternal meal we share with one another, it's a communion with God Himself that unites us with Him. It is that union with God that also unites us with every other person who is united to God through the sharing of the Most Holy Eucharist.

The Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a celebration of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. It's a time to reflect on the mystery of the Eucharist and the profound gift of Jesus' body and blood, given to us as spiritual food and drink.

Some points to reflect deeper on:

- 1. The Real Presence: The core of Corpus Christi is the belief that the bread and wine consecrated during Mass truly become the body and blood of Jesus Christ. This is not a symbolic presence, but a real and substantial one.**
- 2. A Feast of Faith: The feast invites us to deepen our faith in the Eucharist, encouraging us to believe in the mystery of the Real Presence even when it's not visibly apparent. It's a call to trust in Jesus' words and promises.**
- 3. Jesus' Gift of Self: Corpus Christi reminds us that Jesus gave himself entirely for us, first on the cross and then in the Eucharist. It's a celebration of his love and a call to respond with love and gratitude**
- 4. Unity and Community: The Eucharist unites us as the Body of Christ, the Church. Celebrating Corpus Christi strengthens our bonds as a community of believers and encourages us to live out our faith together.**
- 5. Missionary Discipleship: By receiving the Eucharist, we are nourished and strengthened to go out into the world as missionary disciples, sharing the love and grace of Christ with others. We become the presence of Christ in our world.**
- 6. A Call to Action: The feast is not just about contemplation; it's also a call to action. We are invited to live out the Eucharist in our daily lives, showing love, mercy, and compassion to others.**
- 7. Remembering the Last Supper: Corpus Christi is closely linked to the Last Supper, where Jesus instituted the Eucharist. It's a time to remember Jesus' sacrifice and his desire to remain with us always.**

In essence, the Feast of Corpus Christi is a profound celebration of faith, love, and unity, reminding us of the incredible gift of the Eucharist and the transformative power of Jesus' presence in our lives.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, spend time pondering the profound mystery of the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist. As we kneel before Him, we truly kneel before His throne in Heaven, despite the reality being veiled from our eyes. As we consume the Blessed Sacrament, we truly consume Christ Himself—Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity—and receive Him into our souls. Though we might not feel Him with our bodily senses, we must allow our spiritual sense of faith to grow so that our love for Him in this Most Precious Gift exponentially increases.

Prayer: My Eucharistic Lord, please instill in me a profound love for You Who are truly present in the Most Holy Eucharist. May I always adore You, believe in You, hope in You, and love You. I pray that my faith and devotion to You in this Most Holy Sacrament will more fully unite my soul to Yours and that my love and devotion will be a source of reparation for the indifference with which You are so often treated. Jesus, present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar, I trust in You!
