Reflections on this weeks readings- The Words of the Popes



This Sunday's Gospel begins with the question that a lawyer asks Jesus: "Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?" (Lk 10: 25). Knowing him to be expert in Sacred Scripture, the Lord asks this man to give the reply himself; indeed, he formulates it perfectly, citing the two main commandments: you shall love the Lord your God, with all your heart, and with all your mind and with all your strength, and love your neighbor as yourself. Then the lawyer, as if to justify himself, asks: "And who is my neighbor?" (Lk 10: 29). This time, Jesus answers with the famous words of the "Good Samaritan" (cf. Lk 10: 30-37) in order to show that it is up to us to make ourselves the neighbor of all who are in need of help. This Gospel account offers the "standard", that is, "universal love towards the needy whom we encounter 'by chance' (cf. Lk 10: 31), whoever they may be" (Encyclical *Deus Caritas Est*, n. 25). Besides this universal rule there is also a specifically ecclesial requirement: that "in the Church herself, as family, no member should suffer because he is in need" (*ibid.*). The Christian's program, learned from Jesus' teaching, is "a heart which sees" where there is a need for love, and acts accordingly (cf. *ibid.*, n. 31). (Pope Benedict XVI, Angelus, 11 July 2010)



Ministry Highlight—Priest



We all know the general duties of our priest and priests across the world- celebrating Mass, administering sacraments, preaching the Gospel, and providing pastoral care to their community (praying for the sick, performing last rights, etc) but what does it take to *become* a priest?

Basic requirements before starting– To be considered for Seminary, you must be a Catholic male that is single and is at least 18 years of age that feels they have been called to the ministry by God.

Starting out– The process may vary slightly from Diocese to Diocese, but in general it requires a candidate to reach out to a vocation director to begin the process, which includes but is not limited to an autobiography on their life, references from family, friends and teachers, a psychological evaluation and a physical health exam. There is also usually an interview involved.

Once accepted into seminary– The process after being accepted will vary depending on a few factors such as if you have any prior college education starting out. In the US, candidates are required to go through a year of prayer and service called “The Propaedeutic Year,” prior to beginning studies. The Catholic Church mandates that for a man to become an ordained priest, he must study first philosophy, then theology for 4 years.

The course of study may look something like this-

- If needed, College Seminary or 2 years of Pre-Theology
- First Year: I Theology
- Second Year: II Theology
- Third Year: Internship
- Fourth Year: III Theology.
- Ordained a transitional deacon at the end of the Fourth Year.
- Final Year: IV Theology.
- Ordained a Priest at the end of the Final Year.
- After Ordination: Assigned as an Associate Pastor at a parish or high school for approximately 2-3 years.



The whole process from entering the Seminary to being ordained as a priest can take anywhere from 7-10 years depending on if you are preparing to enter a specific order, how much prior education you have and many other factors. The United States Bishops have for a while set out four dimensions of formation: intellectual, pastoral, human, and spiritual. The Catholic seminary is unique in that it focuses on growth in every aspect of the seminarian’s life.

This is, of course, a condensed version of everything that goes into becoming a priest. Many priests go on to continue their education in any number of specialized fields. Next weeks topic...Deacons!
