




Pastors Page Reflection - Fr. Antony - Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Catholic Diocesan Annual Appeal directly connects to the stewardship principle in Luke 16:10 by providing a concrete way for the faithful to demonstrate their faithfulness in small matters and use it for the "true riches" of the Kingdom of God. The appeal is based on the idea that everything we have is a gift from God, and we are called to be generous with these gifts.

Luke 16:10 states, "The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones; and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones." This verse serves as a direct lesson on fidelity and accountability.

Financial Stewardship: Jesus links our handling of "dishonest wealth" (worldly money and possessions) to our spiritual character. How we manage our earthly resources is a test of our trustworthiness and a reflection of our relationship with God.

The "Little" and the "Much": Our financial contributions, even if they seem small to us, are considered "a very little thing" in the grand scheme of God's grace. By giving faithfully, we prove we can be trusted with greater spiritual blessings.

The Diocesan Annual Appeal as an Act of Stewardship

The Diocesan Annual Appeal is not just a fundraising effort; it's presented as an opportunity for parishioners to live out the very principles Jesus taught in Luke 16.

Serving God: The appeal is a way for Catholics to use their money to serve God and the Church, rather than allowing their wealth to become a masters in themselves. Luke 16:13, "You cannot serve God and mammon." It's a tangible act of choosing to prioritize God's work.

Funding Ministry: The funds collected through the appeal support a wide range of diocesan ministries and programs that go beyond the local parish. Each year, our diocese embarks on this appeal to support the essential ministries that serve our entire Catholic family. These are not just distant projects; they are the lifeblood of our local Church. - Support for our parish schools, helping them to continue their mission of providing an excellent Catholic education.


