





Pastors Page Reflection
Fr. Antony
Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The parable of the rich man and the poor Lazarus is not merely a story about wealth and poverty; it is a profound spiritual X-ray of the human heart, revealing the eternal consequences of our choices and our orientation toward others. It offers several powerful spiritual insights for our lives today.

The rich man is not condemned for being wealthy, but for being indifferent. The parable does not say he stole from Lazarus or actively harmed him. His sin was one of omission: he saw the beggar at his gate every day, yet his heart remained hardened, and he failed to act. The greatest spiritual danger for us may not be a monstrous evil, but a passive neglect of those in need right in front of us. This parable is a powerful call to examine our own lives for the "Lazarus" we might be overlooking—the hungry, the lonely, the oppressed—whose suffering we are apathetic toward.

The "great chasm" fixed between the rich man and Lazarus is not a punishment created by God; it is the natural, eternal consequence of the rich man's choices in life. His self-centeredness and lack of love for his neighbor created a spiritual chasm between himself and God's kingdom of mercy. In the afterlife, this spiritual reality simply becomes permanent. The parable teaches us that the way we live our lives, our priorities, and our care (or lack thereof) for others, builds the very reality of our eternity. The chasm is a reflection of the distance the rich man chose to place between himself and others.

The parable dramatically inverts the common understanding of success and failure. The rich man, who was "clothed in purple and fine linen," enjoys worldly honor, while Lazarus is at the bottom of the social ladder. In the afterlife, their positions are completely reversed. This serves as a spiritual reminder that the values of God's kingdom are fundamentally different from those of the world. What is prized by man—wealth, status, comfort—is often meaningless in God's sight, while what is overlooked—suffering, humility, and trust in God—is of eternal value.






