

Mass of Remembrance-

On November 2nd at our 10 AM mass, we will have a Memorial Presentation in remembrance of our loved ones who have passed.

Families are invited to bring a framed 4x6 or 5x7 photo of their loved ones to be placed near the votive candles, where they will remain throughout the month of November, along with a list of those being remembered. On this day, a representative for the family will process into Mass with Father carrying a lit candle that will burn during mass and then be presented to the family member as the names of those being remembered are read aloud. Once all candles have been presented, Father will say a special prayer for the bereaved. All are encouraged to join us for this special liturgy of prayer and remembrance. Since this is our first year doing this, it is open to anyone who wants to honor a loved one, *(in the future this special presentation will be reserved for loved ones that have passed in the prior year.)*

There is a sign-up sheet in the lobby, please register so we can ensure that we have enough memorial candles for those who want to participate.





LUKE 18:9-14

Pastors Page Reflection
Fr. Antony
30th Sunday in Ordinary
Time

*A little boy once prayed,
“Dear Lord, make me good—but not too good, or people won’t like me!”
We laugh—but in that innocent prayer lies a deep truth. Each of us wrestles between the
desire to look good before others and the longing to be truly good before God.*

*Jesus tells in the Gospel of Luke 18:9-14, two men who went to the temple to pray. One was
a Pharisee—devout, disciplined, respected. The other was a tax collector—despised, dis-
trusted, and branded a sinner. Both stood before God. But one spoke from pride, and the
other from pain. When we come to pray, God doesn’t count our words; He weighs our
hearts. The Pharisee had religion but no relationship.
The tax collector had sin—but also sincerity.
He met God not through perfection, but through repentance.*

*St. Augustine once said: “Do you wish to rise? Begin by descending.
You plan a tower that will pierce the clouds? Lay first the foundation of humility.”
God listens most closely to the prayer that comes from the depths of a contrite heart.
A priest once asked the children in catechism class,
“What’s the difference between pride and humility?”
A little girl raised her hand and said,
Father, pride is when you say ‘I don’t need God.’
Humility is when you say, ‘God, I can’t do this without You.’
The Pharisee prayed like God was lucky to have him.
The tax collector prayed like he was lucky to have God.
Fulton J. Sheen said: “The proud man counts his virtues; the humble man counts his
blessings.”*

*The world teaches us to climb higher, but the Gospel teaches us to kneel lower.
Humility is not thinking less of yourself but thinking of yourself less—and thinking of God
more. The humble heart is like a valley—it’s the lowest place, yet it’s where rivers flow.
Grace flows into the humble heart.*

*When Mass ends today and we go home, may it not be like the Pharisee—full of ourselves
but empty of God. May it be like the tax collector—empty of pride, but full of peace,
knowing that God’s mercy is greater than our mistakes.*

*Let our prayer be: “Lord Jesus, have mercy on me, a sinner.
Create in me a humble and contrite heart,
and make my life a song of gratitude to You.”*


