BISHOP ADDS AN OPTIONAL MEMORIAL TO THE 2018 DIOCESAN LITURGICAL CALENDAR IN HONOR OF BLESSED SOLANUS CASEY, OFM CAP: NATIVE SON OF THE DIOCESE OF SUPERIOR JULY 30, 2018

The Capuchins from the Fr. Solanus Guild in Detroit and those from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee recently petitioned the Bishops of the state to add an optional memorial to the diocesan liturgical calendars in honor of Blessed Solanus Casey, OFM Cap.

Chapter Two of the General Norms for the Liturgical Year and the Calendar explains how

a local Ordinary may add a date to his diocesan liturgical calendar:

- 52. A particular calendar is prepared by inserting in the General Calendar special solemnities, feasts, and memorials proper to that calendar:
- a. in a diocesan calendar, in addition to celebrations of its patrons and the dedication of the cathedral, the saints and the blessed who bear some special connection with that diocese, for example, as their birthplace, residence over a long period, or place of death.

Bishop Powers has chosen to honor Blessed Solanus Casey because of his connection with the local Church, with an optional July 30 Memorial in the 2018 diocesan liturgical calendar. The Memorial is celebrated using the readings from that day along with prayers from the Commons section of the Missal: Of Holy Men and Women, "D," For Religious. The Capuchins have also shared the propers for Mass that day, which may alternatively be used. THE SCHOOL OF SERVANT LEADERSHIP AUGUST 2018 - APRIL 2019

School of Servant Leadership is a college level systematic educational, formational and transformational learning process, taught by quality Professors from Viterbo University, La Crosse, WI, in conjunction with Diocesan Educators. It is open to Clergy, Parish Life Coordinators, Parish Directors, Religious Sisters, DREs, CREs, Youth/Young Adult Ministers, Principals, Teachers, Diocesan Staff, Parish Administrators, Parish Development Directors, Parish Nurses, and Lay Ministers and those seeking continuing formation hours for Forming Effective Disciples (FED). It is also a prerequisite for those men discerning application to the permanent diaconate. It consists of nine courses, one weekend per month for nine months; participants must be able to commit to all nine courses, as a cohort learning model will be utilized. There is a limit of 25 participants in the cohort. Reserve a seat ASAP as registration will be on a first come, first serve basis. The program runs August-April in Tony. CHANGES FOR LTP ORDERING LITURGICAL TRAINING PUBLICATIONS

Following a review of the LTP ordering by parishes through the Diocesan Office of Worship, which allows for a 40% discount, some changes will take effect August 1, 2018. Parishes may continue to send orders to the Diocese via email, fax, or mail.

- The Office of Worship will place orders twice a year fall and spring only.
- The invoice, included with the products upon delivery, must be paid to LTP within 30 days. If it is not paid, the Diocesan account with LTP will be put on hold for all parishes.
- A shipping fee which is \$7 minimum and based on weight, along with a \$4 drop shipment fee are included in the invoice. If the distance between the parish and the Chancery is short, the \$4 drop shipment fee could be eliminated if the parish would like to pick up the order at the Chancery. E-orders and orders placed outside of the Diocesan fall and spring order dates are not eligible for the Diocesan discount. In July, a reminder of last year's order will be sent to parishes to ensure ample time to place the order with the Diocesan Office of Worship before Advent.
