We'd also like to share some tips from the FBI to make sure that your online meetings are secure.

- Make meetings private by requiring a meeting password or using a waiting room feature to control who's admitted.
- Don't share a link to the meeting on a public social media post. Send the link to people directly.
- Change the screen-sharing option in Zoom to "host only".
- Ask people to use the latest updated version of Zoom.
