REV. WILLIAM JOSEPH CARY III, age 90, died on Saturday, August 14, 2021, at St. Camillus, Wauwatosa, WI. No public services were scheduled for **Fr. Cary**. The following information was sent to the Chancery today, Thursday, August 26, 2021.

Father William Joseph Cary III died on Saturday, August 14, 2021, at Saint Camillus in Wauwatosa, Wisconsin. He moved there from his residence in Neenah, Wisconsin on April 14, 2021, after a sudden onset of problems and limitations. At St. Camillus, he observed his 90th birthday, having been born in Milwaukee on June 5, 1931.

In the course of his seminary education, he decided to transfer from the mostly urban and populated Archdiocese of Milwaukee to the rural and natural Diocese of Superior. Fr. Cary was ordained on May 31,1958 for the Diocese of Superior at the Cathedral of Christ the King by Bishop Joseph Annabring. During his time in the north, he enjoyed all aspects of outdoor activities in all seasons.

In his retirement, Fr. Cary was a voracious reader, even compiling pages of salient quotations into ring binders. He was an avid viewer of movies at home through his DVD player. He enjoyed keeping up on news and events via his computer link to the internet. He never shied from an anecdote, observation or quip.

Fr. Cary is survived by his brother James, his niece Catherine Halfmann (Thomas), his nephew William J. Cary IV (Marlene), their children with their spouses and children.

His mortal remains are buried in the family plot near his parents and other relatives at Calvary Cemetery in Milwaukee.
