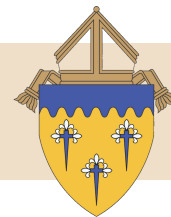

### MOBILE MEXICAN CONSULATE | SATURDAY, MAY 20, 2023

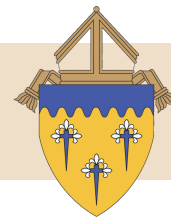

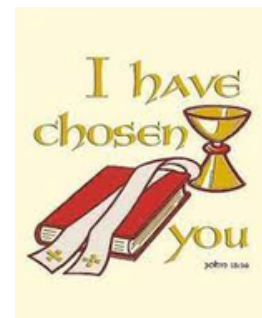

Light refreshments will be served at the reception in Kress Hall which follows the Mass.

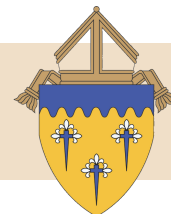

### MOMENT OF PRAYER FOR THE SYNOD | WEDNESDAY, MAY 31, 2023

All parishes in the Diocese of Superior are invited to observe a moment of prayer on Wednesday, May 31, the feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, in support of the upcoming first session of the 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops.

The shape of the moment of prayer will vary from parish to parish. Some examples include a Eucharistic Holy Hour, recitation of the Rosary, or the celebration of the Liturgy of the Hours. As May 31 also concludes the traditional month of Mary, the Synod moment of prayer could also be incorporated into previously planned Marian devotions for the day. In addition to the moment of prayer itself, the celebration of Mass in parishes that day could be enriched in one or more ways: recitation of the Prayer for the Synod beforehand, special petitions during the Universal Prayer, or the Hail Mary after the dismissal. ### **SOLEMNITY OF THE LORD'S ASCENSION | SUNDAY, MAY 21, 2023**

In 2006, the Catholic Bishops of Wisconsin voted to transfer the Solemnity of the Lord's Ascension from Thursday of the 6th Week of Easter to the 7th Sunday of Easter. This was intended to allow a greater number of people to celebrate the feast with due solemnity in the context of the Mass. In 2023 the Ascension of the Lord is observed on Sunday, May 21. It may not be celebrated on any other day in the Dioceses of Wisconsin.

### **MEMORIAL DAY | MONDAY, MAY 29, 2023**

Memorial Day is one of the four special days of prayer in the Diocese of Superior. The focus of prayer for this particular day is the promotion of peace and justice. The Mass for the Preservation of Peace and Justice may be used (Masses for Various Needs and Occasions, section II, number 30), along with readings found at Lectionary numbers 887-891.

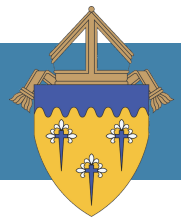

### **OBLIGATORY MEMORIAL: THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY, MOTHER OF THE CHURCH | MONDAY, MAY 29, 2023**

On February 11, 2018 the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments issued a decree implementing Pope Francis' decision this memorial be inscribed in the General Roman Calendar and observed on the Monday after Pentecost, taking precedence over any conflicting obligatory memorial. 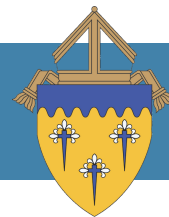

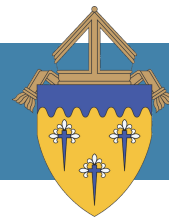

Initial Formation sessions for those seeking initial diocesan certification as lay leaders of prayer are September 22 & 23 and November 3 & 4. Attendance at both sessions is required. The venue is yet to be announced but will most likely take place in the western part of the diocese. Both sessions begin Friday evening and conclude late Saturday afternoon. All lay people who lead Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest or weekday Communion services in their parish church buildings should be recipients of this certification. Please note: Applicants must be specifically selected and recommended by their pastor, parish life coordinator or parish director via a completed application form and also registered to attend.

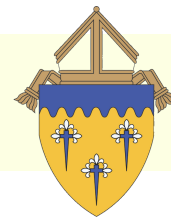

On Saturday, May 6 at St. Mary's in Bruce there will be a Day of Reflection for women who are part of the Seven Sisters Apostolate and any woman interested in offering a weekly Holy Hour for our priests. Since the first group began in 2013, there were 29 groups at the beginning of the pandemic. This gathering hopes to renew those women and involve more to reach even more priests in the Diocese of Superior with the gift of dedicated prayer. 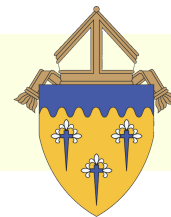

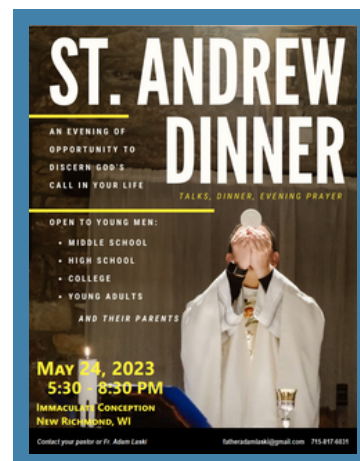

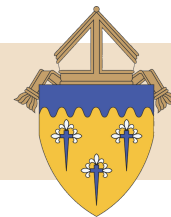
