


WEBSITE UPDATE - VOLUNTEER ACCESS


RESPECT LIFE PARISH KITS ARRIVING LATE AUGUST / EARLY SEPTEMBER




SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY | TUESDAY, AUGUST 15, 2023

Because the celebration of the Assumption falls on a Tuesday this year it is a Holy Day of Obligation. Whenever August 15 falls on a Saturday or a Monday, the Solemnity is still celebrated, but the faithful's obligation to attend Mass is dropped.

FEAST DAY OF OUR DIOCESAN PATRON | MONDAY, AUGUST 28, 2023

St. Augustine of Hippo is the Patron Saint of the Diocese of Superior. Because of this, his Memorial is celebrated in our diocese as a Feast. Mass then includes the Gloria and the preface of Holy Pastors. Alternate readings for that day may be found in the Lectionary at number 633 or could be taken from either the Common of Pastors or the Common of Doctors of the Church.
