3. April 16, 2024

"Marriage and Family: The Domestic Church"

Mrs. Loree Nauertz is the Associate Director of Evangelization and Missionary Discipleship, as well as the lead staff member for Marriage & Family Ministry for the Diocese of Superior. She will help participants understand the importance of marriage and family as the Domestic Church, and as the primary venue for family formation and creating fertile ground for discernment of a vocational calling: marriage & family, single life, religious life, priesthood and the permanent diaconate.
