# Sacraments of Initiation for Adults | Quick Reference Guide

### **Baptized Adult**

Uncatechized, Catholic

- Rites from OCIA Part II, Chapter V
- Lengthy preparation (1 year+) that mirrors the catechumenate
- Reconciliation before Sacraments
- Reception into Full Communion at the Easter Vigil with:
  - Confirmation
  - Eucharist
- Delegation required

### **Baptized Adult**

Catechized, Catholic

- This is usually an adult Confirmation candidate who has already received First Communion, though occasionally the reverse (especially for some Hispanics)
- Prepare for Confirmation (and / or First Communion) and fill in gaps of catechetical formation
- Confirmed by pastor on an appropriate Feast (e.g. Pentecost) or by Bishop with other Confirmandi
- Do NOT confirm at Easter Vigil
- Delegation required

### **Baptized Adult**

Uncatechized, Non-Catholic

- Rites from OCIA Part II, Chapter V
- Lengthy preparation (1 year+) that mirrors the catechumenate
- Reconciliation before Reception
- Reception into Full Communion at the Easter Vigil with:
  - Confirmation
  - Eucharist
- No delegation required
- Entered into Baptismal register as Received into Full Communion

## **Baptized Adult**

Catechized, Non-Catholic

- Rites from OCIA Part II, Chapter VI
- No further burden than necessary to restore communion & unity
- Reconciliation before Reception
- Reception into Full Communion at the same celebration with:
  - Confirmation
  - Eucharist
- Any Sunday or Feast Day
- No delegation required
- Entered into Baptismal register as Reception into Full Communion

# **Unbaptized Adult**

- Rites from OCIA Part I
- Lengthy Preparation (1 year+)
- Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil
  - Baptism
  - Confirmation
  - Eucharist
- No delegation required

### In danger of death (all ages, situation)

- Utilize the rite in OCIA Part II, Chapter IV & Order of the Anointing of the Sick and Their Pastoral Care
  - o Baptism, Confirmation, & First Communion if any not yet received
- No delegation required

# Sacraments of Initiation for Children | Quick Reference Guide

# **Unbaptized Child**

Age 0 - 6

- Infant baptism according to typical norms (Order of Baptism of Children)
- Do not form or assess "readiness" of child
- No delegation required
- Prepare for Eucharist, Confirmation on "typical" timeline

## **Unbaptized Child**

Age 7 - 17

- Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil or other suitable time:
  - Baptism
  - Confirmation
  - Eucharist
- Use adaptations of Order of Initiation as outlined in OCIA Part II, Chapter II
- No delegation required

## **Baptized Child**

Non-Catholic, Age 0 - 6

- Received into Full Communion at the will of the parents
- Chapter VI of Order of Baptism of Children: "Order of Bringing a Baptized Child to the Church"
- Anytime
- No delegation required
- Entered into Baptismal register as Reception into Full Communion
- Prepare for Eucharist, Confirmation on typical timeline

### **Baptized Child**

Non-Catholic, Age 7 - 17

- See above "Baptized Adult, Non-Catholic"
- Receive into Church with Profession of Faith
  - Confirmation
  - Eucharist
- When the candidate is ready
- Public or Private
- No delegation required
- Entered into Baptismal register as Reception into Full Communion
- Should still participate in normal catechesis after reception of Sacraments

# **Baptized Child**

Catholic, First Communion not received, Age 0 - 6

 Prepare for Eucharist and Confirmation on typical timeline

# **Baptized Child**

Catholic, First Communion not received, Age 7 - 17

- Reception of First Holy Communion
- When the child is ready
- No delegation required
- Prepare for Confirmation on typical timeline

### In danger of death (all ages, situation)

- Utilize the rite in OCIA Part II, Chapter IV & Order of the Anointing of the Sick and Their Pastoral Care
  - o Baptism, Confirmation, & First Communion if any not yet received
- No delegation required

\*Order of Reception into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church of Those Already Validly Baptized

\*If under 7, still need to be received and recorded as having been received publicly, but uses the ritual in Chapter VI of the Order of Baptism of Children: Order of Bringing a Baptized Child to the Church, which includes the explanatory rites and blessings, as well as receiving Catholic sponsors/godparents)

Missing 1<sup>st</sup> Communion and / or Confirmation beyond normal age of reception
