Dear Pastors, Parochial Administrators, Sacramental Ministers, Parish Directors, and Parish Life Coordinators,

Happy Advent! I hope that your journey to welcoming Christ more fully into your lives has been fruitful thus far.

We have come a long way in our diocese since *Bishop's Pastoral Letter on Evangelization* was written and released on Pentecost of 2023, as well as the official roll out of the *Maintenance to Mission Pastoral Plan: Recalibrating our Structures to Move on Mission* and the establishment of the Office of Parish Transformation on February 18, 2025. We have much to celebrate as we continue on the journey of solidarity in keeping the *main thing, the main thing:* evangelization, spreading the Good News of the Gospel, inviting people to authentic discipleship in Jesus Christ, holding the Eucharist as the *source and summit* of our efforts, and being intentional in our restoration of apostolic zeal in the Diocese of Superior. As we partner with *The Office of Evangelization & Missionary Discipleship,* we also celebrate the establishment of *Encounter: Parish Mission Apostolate.* 

As you continue to work on your annual goals, which will be due to the Office of Parish Transformation (cnewkirk@catholicdos.org) no later than May 15, 2026, please feel free to reach out to myself or your Office of Parish Transformation representative for any support and accompaniment you may need. Please also continue to reach out to Christopher Hurtubise for additional support and resources for evangelization. We are here to serve you, support you, guide you, accompany you and to celebrate with you on your continued journey.

The question was asked at the clergy workshop regarding, "What about the 3–5-year goal setting?" For this first round of submissions, it is hoped that you concentrate on a deep analysis of current Parish realities (Parish Annual Snapshots, Pillar IV Checklist), where you can immediately begin to improve and continue to form a deeper understanding of evangelization, mission, expanding the prayer life, Eucharistic Adoration opportunities and continual formation for your leadership teams, councils and parishioners in general. If you are ready to set 3–5-year goals and want to include them with your May 15, 2026, submission, please feel free to do so by indicating in the *comment section* that it is a multi-year goal.

The Diocesan staff have been working on our goals as well. One immediate goal that we have already started to implement is to have a more extensive prayer time at all diocesan meetings. Another aspect that we have begun to work on is collective professional development as diocesan staff. We have now had two-day long formation sessions with representatives from Divine Renovation and will have two more in the Spring of 2026. As a result, we have also just become aware of an opportunity from Divine Renovation that is available to priests in our diocese and throughout the US. I realize how busy this time of year can be and that this is short notice, however, I felt it was still important to offer this opportunity for those whose schedules allow participation. It is a formational series called *KickStart* and is specifically aimed at leadership formation and coaching for priests.
