#### WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING WITH ME?

- Layers of comfortable, casual clothing for varying temperatures both indoors and outdoors.
- Quilt or comforter (blankets are not provided)
- Alarm clock
- Toothbrush/toiletries (also available for a nominal charge)
- Flip flops or shower shoes
- Books, journals, etc., to quiet your heart, mind, and soul.

St. Anthony's also provides: soap, clothes hangers, bed and bath linens, and fans, as well as a limited number of alarm clocks, hair dryers, and space heaters.

#### Snacks and Beverages

Meals will be provided, but many people like to bring snacks for the evenings, as well as their favorite beverages. (The retreat center does allow alcoholic beverages, but our event has traditionally had a "no alcohol" policy.)

Last, but not least: remember that your time of retreat is a time of simplicity: a time to disconnect and hit the pause button. We encourage you to leave your cell phone, laptop, and other electronic devices at home or powered off and stored in your car for the duration of your stay. A guest telephone and computer are available for your use in an emergency. Please do not move any furniture from its original position.

#### ARRIVAL | CONCLUSION & FACILITY ACCESS

Check-in begins any time after 5:00 p.m. Friday evening. There will be a short but mandatory orientation in the retreat center chapel conducted by St. Anthony staff at 7:15, perhaps followed by Evening Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours or Holden Evening Prayer. The retreat concludes at noon on Sunday with lunch.

Exterior doors are locked at all times, however the "ramp door" will remain open for our group. If this changes it will be announced at orientation.

LITURGICAL MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES | If the Sacred Liturgy is the work of the people, many hands make light work! Please indicate your willingness to volunteer in one or more of the required ministries listed in your registration. The more ministries you can volunteer for will provide greater ease in assigning ministries among the volunteers. Thank you!

If we have our own Priest in attendance in 2025, changes to Mass and Reconciliation options will be announced.

MASS AND THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION | The retreat center chapel remains open and useable. However, St. Anthony's is currently not able to provide a Priest for on-site celebrations of Mass and/or the Sacraments. Therefore, these opportunities are provided by Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church, located at 712 Market Street in Marathon, 715-443-2045.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation may be available immediately after Saturday morning Mass. Saturday Mass at 8:00 a.m. is occasionally replaced by a weekday Communion service (due to staffing issues). Should this occur, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will not be available due to the lack of a Priest. Consideration in the unlikely event of a funeral would also impact Reconciliation availability. Please note: Attendance at Saturday Morning parish Mass, if it does take place, does not fulfill one's Sunday obligation.

Saturday evening Mass at 4:00 p.m. (the anticipated weekend Mass) is encouraged over Sunday morning to allow for more time on Sunday for rehearsal and communal lunch prior to departure.

Getting there: The 0.7 mile route from the retreat Center to the parish church is walkable, with the final portion somewhat (fairly steeply) uphill. If you are driving there, note that Market Street is a one-way street going downhill.

The St. Anthony Spirituality Center has a variety of rooms to suit attendees:

Available to parent/s with minor/s, or those with mobility issues.

Multiple occupancy charge for a suite.

Double Suite (2 guests-1 bed, private bathroom.)
Available to parent/s with minor/s, or those with mobility issues.
Multiple occupancy charge for a suite.

#### "FAMILY EVENT" | INCLUSION OF MINORS IN CHORALE ACTIVITIES

The Bishops' Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People sets forth very specific requirements for activities that include minors. For youth less than 18 years of age to be included in Chorale events, we must assure that these events can be defined as a Family Event as set up by the Diocese of Superior. To be a FAMILY EVENT, every minor must be accompanied by at least one parent, or their court-appointed legal guardian for the entire duration of the event. This includes 24-hour supervision to assure the safety and appropriate behavior of each participating youth.

SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS -PROTOCOLS FOR FAMILY EVENTS | A Standard Double room is equipped with one double bed. Do not move beds from other rooms into the room you're sharing with your children. The large ("Bishop's") suite also has a regular couch (non-fold out) available for one person to sleep on. All other necessary bedding, pillows along with any necessary air mattresses or cots must be brought from your home.

- Participating minors must share a room with their supervising parent/s or legal guardian/s.
- Rooms assigned to families normally include one double bed and a private bathroom.
- Any occupancy beyond two would then require the remainder to sleep on the floor of the room.

SHOWERING PROTOCOLS | All minors are to use the private bathroom in their shared room for showering.

SUPERVISION OF MINORS | Regarding attendees who are minors, in 2023 the St. Anthony Retreat Center also requires constant physical parental/legal guardian supervision.

BREAKDOWN OF RETREAT COSTS | It is our desire for all Chorale Members, new and old, to attend the retreat, regardless of their ability to pay. Our suggested minimum again remains \$45.00/per person. 
