FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

DO NOT FEAR. This particular phrase or its equivalent was mentioned 365 times in the Bible. A whole year has 365 days. As if God is telling us not to be afraid daily - to trust in God always. This is a reassuring word from God so, as a response we must take courage. Let me share to you a reflection I came across about courage.

Courage is connected with taking risks. Jumping the Grand Canyon on a motorbike, coming over Niagara Falls in a barrel, or crossing the ocean in a rowboat are called courageous acts because people risk their lives by doing these things. But none of these daredevil acts comes from the center of our being. They all come from the desire to test our physical limits and to become famous and popular.

Spiritual courage is something completely different. It is following the deepest desires of our hearts at the risk of losing fame and popularity. It asks of us the willingness to lose our temporal lives in order to gain eternal life.

"Have courage," we often say to one another. Courage is a spiritual virtue. The word courage comes from the Latin word *cor*, which means "heart." A courageous act is an act coming from the heart. A courageous word is a word arising from the heart. The heart, however, is not just the place where our emotions are located. The heart is the center of our being, the center of all thoughts, feelings, passions, and decisions.

A courageous life, therefore, is a life lived from the center. It is a deeply rooted life, the opposite of a superficial life. "Have courage" therefore means "Let your center speak." As Christians, we make Christ the center of our being. And so, being courageous means letting Christ rule over our life. Without Christ we are nothing, but with Christ as the center and focus of our being, we can achieve great and wonderful things.
