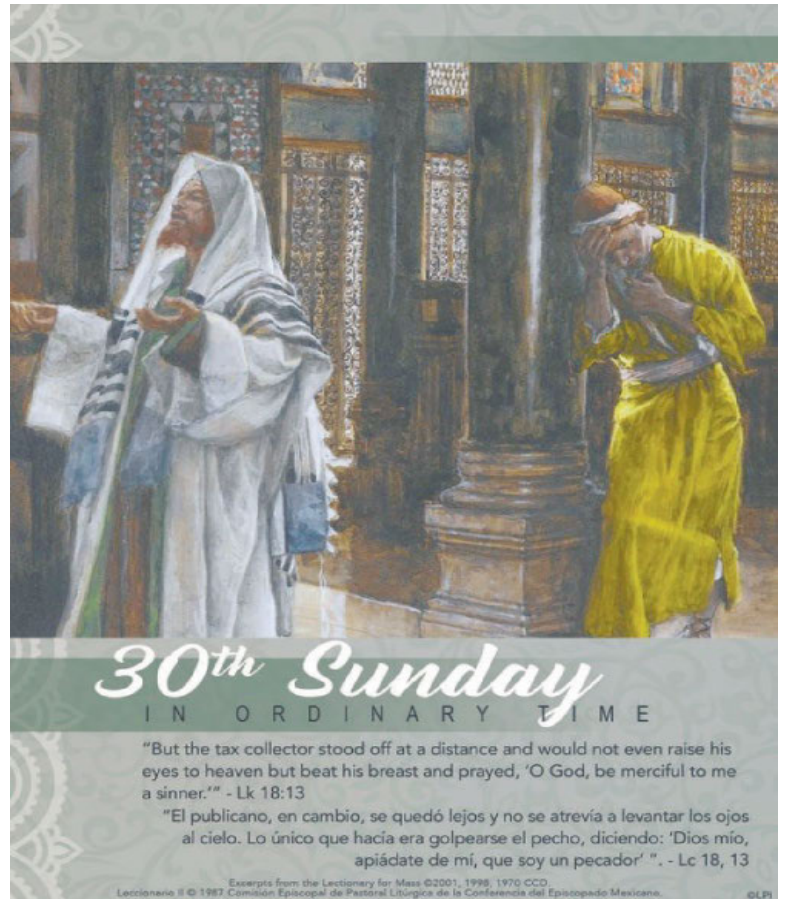

If you anticipate hospitalization or require sacraments, please call the parish office. For emergencies call 815-206-9201 leave a message and your call will be returned as soon as possible.

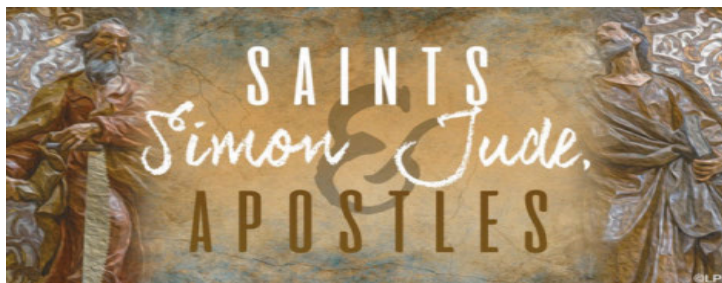

PADRE LOAIZA

COMO LE PRESENTAMOS A DIOS NUESTRA ORACION?

Las lecturas de hoy nos hablan de cómo debe ser nuestra relación con Dios. De la actitud con que debemos presentarnos ante Dios, nuestro Padre. Y para darnos a entender la actitud que debemos de tener para con Dios y los hombres, Jesús presenta esta parábola: del fariseo y del publicano.

El fariseo es el personaje consciente de su buen comportamiento, que compara y enjuicia precisamente en base a su cumplimiento. No es por tanto un personaje orgulloso cuanto un personaje que reza y se comporta desde sus derechos.

El publicano es el personaje consciente de su mal comportamiento. Por eso no compara nunca ni enjuicia nunca. Es el personaje que cree tener siempre obligaciones. Nunca derecho sobre los demás. Publicano es el que se da cuenta de que el mal no está solamente fuera, sino dentro de él. El que se da cuenta de que él también está implicado en el mal, que no tiene las manos limpias, que no puede echar la culpa solo a los demás, sino que también él tiene que convertirse, cambiar personalmente. Y la única arma eficaz que tenemos contra él es la del publicano. Es decir: reconocer con sencillez que somos unos fariseos. Nuestra oración debería ser: Señor, ten compasión de este fariseo que hay en mí.

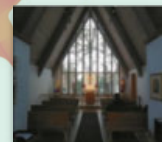

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

St. Dominic de Guzman is the saint to whom Our Lady appeared in a small town in southern France. In that apparition, Our Lady gave the devotion of the Holy Rosary to assist him in fighting against the Albigensian heresy. The Blessed Mother assured St. Dominic that if he would preach her rosary and its meditations on the life of Christ, many souls would be converted from their error and saved through her intercession. The Blessed Virgin said to him:

"Wonder not that you have obtained so little fruit by your labors. You have spent them on barren soil, not yet watered with the dew of Divine grace. When God willed to renew the face of the earth, He began by sending down on it the fertilizing rain of the Angelic Salutation. Therefore, preach my Psalter composed of 150 Angelic Salutations and 15 Our Fathers, and you will obtain an abundant harvest."

This month we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. It was formerly known as Our Lady of Victory. Pope Pius V instituted this feast to commemorate the victory of Don John of Austria over the Turkish fleet at the naval battle of Lepanto on the 7th of October 1571. The Pope organized a rosary procession on that day in St. Peter's Square in Rome. Though heavily outnumbered, the Christian forces won over the Muslim forces, preventing them from overrunning Western Europe. The victory was generally attributed to the heavenly intervention and intercession of the Mother of God.

Sister Lucia, one of the visionaries at the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, said, "In these last times in which we live, the Most Holy Virgin has given a new power to the recitation of the Holy Rosary. There is no problem that cannot be solved by the Rosary; no matter how difficult it is, whether temporal or above all, spiritual, in the personal life of each one of us, of our families, of the families of the world, or of the religious communities, or even of the life of peoples and nations."

Why is the holy rosary so powerful and effective? There are two main reasons for this. First, because it is a simple and humble prayer. Those who pray it are formed spiritually in littleness, in meekness, in simplicity of heart. This is precisely the weapon against the pride and arrogance of the devil. In her message, the Blessed Mother said, "Satan's pride will again be conquered by the humility of little ones, and the Red Dragon will find himself decisively humiliated and defeated when I bind him, not by a great chain, but by a very frail cord: the holy rosary." (To The Priests, Our Lady's Beloved Sons, Msg 275).

And second, the rosary is powerful because it is a prayer that is said together with the Mother of God herself. When we pray the rosary, we do not pray to Mary; rather, we pray together with her. In the same message, she said, "When you invite me to pray for you, I accede to your request and mingle my voice with yours, and I unite my prayer to yours. Consequently it becomes more and more efficacious. What I ask for I always obtain, because Jesus can never say no to what his Mother requests of Him."

In the many apparitions of the Blessed Mother all over the world, she would invariably ask: "Please pray the Rosary." In one of her messages, she said, "I request it from all with solicitude and maternal preoccupation." Obviously, it is the prayer that she particularly likes. Let us always remember this. There are many novenas and devotions that we can use in our daily prayers. But the prayer that the Blessed Mother expressly requested for and which surely pleases and makes her happy is the rosary.

Let me illustrate this with an example: If a mother sends her child to the store to buy milk, and he returns with ice cream, will she be pleased? Of course, ice cream is better than milk, but it is not what she asked for." This is similar with her request for us to pray the rosary. And if we want to please Jesus, we must do what His Mother asks.
