### CUANTAS VECES TENGO QUE PERDONAR?

La presente parábola concreta todavía más. ¿Qué medida utilizará Dios al final de los tiempos, la de la misericordia o la del juicio severo? La parábola se convierte ahora en una seria advertencia. La medida de Dios será de misericordia. Menos para aquellos "que no tuvieron compasión de sus compañeros, como yo tuve compasión de ti". El Padre será juez "si cada cual no perdona de corazón a su hermano", porque no ha transmitido lo que recibió. El perdón es la única posibilidad de amar en un mundo en que la cruz de Cristo nos habla de la existencia del mal. No necesitamos cerrar los ojos v fingir hombres que no existen. Amamos perdonando. La parábola del empleado inicuo quiere devolver el problema al único horizonte en que puede ser resuelto: Si Dios perdona graciosamente las mayores deudas, nadie puede aducir razones válidas para negar el perdón a otro.
