## FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

The obedience of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a cornerstone of her revered status in Christianity.

## PADRE LOAIZA

### EUCARISTIA BANQUETE DEL SENOR

En el evangelio, Jesús describe el reino de Dios como un gran banquete de boda, con abundancia de alimentos y bebidas, en un clima de alegría y fiesta que embarga a todos los convidados. Al mismo tiempo, Jesús subraya la necesidad del "traje de fiesta" (Mt 22, 11), es decir, la necesidad de respetar las condiciones requeridas para la participación en esa fiesta solemne. La imagen del banquete está presente también en la primera lectura, tomada del libro del profeta Isaías, donde se subrayan la universalidad de la invitación "para todos los pueblos" (Is 25, 6) y la desaparición de todos los sufrimientos y dolores: "Dios enjugará las lágrimas de todos los rostros" (Is 25, 8). Son las grandes promesas de Dios, que se cumplieron en la redención realizada por Cristo, y que la Iglesia, en su misión evangelizadora, anuncia y ofrece a todos los hombres. La comunión de vida con Dios y con los hermanos, que por obra del Espíritu Santo se actúa en la existencia de los creyentes, tiene su centro en el banquete eucarístico, fuente y cumbre de toda la experiencia cristiana.

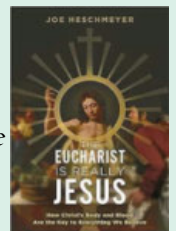
