#### FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

Son las grandes promesas de Dios, que se cumplieron en la redención realizada por Cristo, y que la Iglesia, en su mission evangelizadora, anuncia y ofrece a todos los hombres. La comunión de vida con Dios y con los hermanos, que por obra del Espíritu Santo se actúa en la existencia de los creventes, tiene su centro en el banquete eucarístico, fuente y cumbre de toda la experiencia cristiana.


