FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO

The humility of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a cherished virtue that has captivated the hearts of countless believers for centuries. Mary's profound humility is a central theme in Christian theology and serves as an enduring example of how a humble heart can play a pivotal role in God's divine plan.

One of the most iconic moments that highlights Mary's humility is the Annunciation. When the angel Gabriel appeared to her, announcing that she would conceive and give birth to the Son of God, her response was a testament to her deep humility. Instead of questioning or doubting, Mary simply said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word" (Luke 1:38). Her presence there was a testament to her unwavering humility and love for God's plan. The Blessed Virgin Mary's example serves as a powerful reminder for believers of the importance of humility in their own lives. Her example teaches us that true greatness lies in surrendering our pride and ego to God's will, accepting our roles as servants of the Lord. Mary's humility not only made her an integral part of God's redemptive plan but also a beloved and enduring symbol of humble devotion for Christians worldwide.
