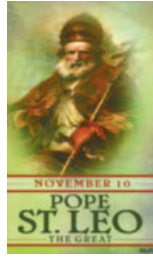

TESTIMONIO

El discípulo de Jesús tiene que actuar de modo muy distinto: tiene que cargarse su cruz, él, y seguir al Maestro; y tiene que actuar, no de cara a la galería, para hacerse ver de la gente, sino "en el secreto", en la verdad de su corazón: "Y tu Padre, que ve en el secreto, te lo recompensará" (Mt 6. 4/6/18). Con otras palabras, el discípulo tiene que hacer como su Maestro, que se cargó una cruz bien pesada, pero que era compasivo con la gente sencilla, con los publicanos y los pecadores; y que no buscaba el aplauso de los hombres, sino complacer al padre. Los discípulos de Jesús tenemos que ser todos hermanos, al mismo nivel unos de otros. Desdichadamente hay aún entre nosotros compartimentos, clases y privilegios, que son más propios de una sinagoga de notables o de señores de este mundo. No tendría que ser así. En la Iglesia, en nuestras comunidades y grupos cristianos, tenemos que sentirnos con toda libertad los unos para con los otros. Nadie es "maestro" ni "padre" ni "jefe". Somos un pueblo de hermanos con un Padre, un Señor y Maestro.
