




#### **TESTIMONIO**

Desdichadamente hay aún entre nosotros compartimentos, clases y privilegios, que son más propios de una sinagoga de notables o de señores de este mundo. No tendría que ser así. En la Iglesia, en nuestras comunidades y grupos cristianos, tenemos que sentirnos con toda libertad los unos para con los otros. Nadie es "maestro" ni "padre" ni "jefe". Somos un pueblo de hermanos con un Padre, un Señor y Maestro.


