

#### 2023 is the Year of the Charitable Gift Annuity!

- CGA rates for 2023 are the highest they've been in a decade.
- Congress just allowed an IRA owner to make a one-time \$50,000 election to make a QCD fund a CGA (and starting in 2024 it will adjust annually for inflation).
- The \$100,000 cap for QCDs will be increasing annually for inflation.
- Retirees must take taxable IRA withdrawals at age 73 in 2023 and at 75 by 2023. IRA owners can take a QCD starting at age 70 1/2.

#### DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PADRE LOAIZA



NOVIEMBRE MES DE LOS FIELES DIFUNTOS

Después de la festividad del 1 de noviembre, fecha en la que se celebra el <u>Día de Todos los Santos</u>, se conmemora otra fecha relevante en el calendario eclesiástico, el <u>Día de los</u>

Difuntos. Se trata de dos acontecimientos que en ocasiones pueden llegar a confundirse, pero que presentan diferencias, a pesar de que en <u>ambas se rememora a los seres queridos</u>.

Mientras en el primer caso se honra a tanto a los santos conocidos como a los desconocidos, es decir, a las personas no canonizadas pero que ya viven en presencia de Dios, el <u>Día de</u>

los Difuntos recuerda a los cristianos bautizados. En concreto, la Iglesia cree que este grupo de fallecidos se encuentra en el Purgatorio, al morir con culpa de pecados menores en sus almas. Por ello, la finalidad de esta fecha es la dedicación a la oración por parte de los fieles por todas las almas que han acabado su vida terrenal y aún permanecen en estado de purificación. De esta manera, la jornada del 2 de noviembre se dedica a la oración para que los fieles difuntos de la Iglesia purgante acaben esta etapa y alcancen la presencia de Dios.

#### El origen de la celebración

El origen del Día de los Difuntos se encuentra en el año 998, cuando fue instituido por el monje benedictino San Odilón de Francia. Esta celebración que tiene lugar el 2 de noviembre fue adoptada por Roma en el siglo XVI y a partir de entonces comenzó a rememorarse entre los católicos de todo el mundo. La celebración concretamente se basa en la doctrina de que las almas de los fieles que al tiempo de morir no han sido limpiadas de pecados veniales, o que no han hecho expiación por transgresiones del pasado, no pueden alcanzar la Visión Beatífica, y que se les puede ayudar a alcanzarla por rezos y por el sacrificio de la misa.


