



This Sunday we are celebrating the feast of Epiphany. The term Epiphany is of Greek origin. It is a combination of two words: epi which is an adverb of place, meaning around; and phanes which means manifestation or revelation. In a broader sense, Epiphany invites us to seek

revelations in unexpected places, to embrace moments of clarity that illuminate our paths. It's a beacon, reminding us that profound discoveries often lie just beyond the familiar. In a religious sense, it invites us to see Jesus in every moment of our life. He is Emmanuel – God is with us.

The Feast of the Epiphany commemorates the revelation of Jesus to the world, symbolized by the visit of the Magi. It's a celebration of light, representing the manifestation of divinity in human form and the universal message of hope, inclusion, and spiritual awakening. This feast reminds us that profound truths can be found by those who seek with an open heart, transcending boundaries and welcoming all on their journey.

FIESTA DE LA EPIFANIA DEL SENOR

Epifanía significa: Manifestación, viene del griego. Siginfica el Señor se ha revelado al mundo pagano representado en las personas de los Reyes magos. La Fiesta de la Epifanía es una de las fiestas litúrgicas más antiguas de la Iglesia,

incluso aún más que la Navidad. Esta fiesta comenzó a celebrarse en Oriente en el siglo III y en Occidente. La fe es la luz por la que reconocemos a Dios. Es una estrella que nos lleva a Cristo. Es un don de Dios, una iluminación, no una propiedad nuestra. Cristo dijo: "Nadie puede venir a mí si no es atraído por el Padre que me envió" (Jn 6,44). No se puede llegar a la luz de la verdad revelada mediante el recurso exclusivo de la razón humana. Dios es el que revela; él es el que "iluminó nuestros corazones para que brille el conocimiento de la gloria de Dios, que brilla en el rostro de Cristo" (2 Cor 4,6).

Mediante la fe conocemos realmente a Dios, aunque este conocimiento sea oscuro, "como a través de un espejo, de manera oscura o borrosa". Es un conocimiento que nos une a Dios y lleva consigo, incluso en la tierra, la "garantía" y la sustancia de las cosas esperadas (cf Heb 11,1). Caminamos en fe, no en visión. Nos asemejamos al piloto de aviación que pilota su aeroplano en la noche. No ve absolutamente nada fuera de su cabina. Fiándose de sus instrumentos, sabe que se encuentra en la ruta correcta. También la fe nos sitúa en nuestra ruta, nos muestra el camino que tenemos que recorrer.



They will check the Carotid Arteries on both sides of the neck for fatty plaque build-up which accounts for 80% of all strokes. They check the Abdominal Aorta which is the main Artery off the Heart for Aneurysms, the Thyroid which controls the Metabolism for cyst, nodules and enlargements, the Liver, Gallbladder and both Kidney's for cyst, masses, fluid build-up and tumors.

These screenings are typically NOT performed at annual check-ups, nor will insurance companies pay for them unless you are symptomatic. Collectively, these screenings cost thousands in a hospital. Stroke Scan will be offering them to you for \$169 for all 7 combined. Health/Flex Savings Accounts are accepted. Please call 866-935-7226 to schedule an appointment today. A representative will be visiting the weekend of January 6th/7th to answer questions and for pre-registration. Prevention is the KEY to early detection.
