



FROM THE DESK OF FATHER PAVINO



Last Wednesday, February 14th, we celebrated Ash Wednesday and entered into a new season in the Liturgical calendar – the Season of Lent. Lent is the solemn Christian religious observance in the liturgical year commemorating the 40 days Jesus Christ

spent fasting in the desert and enduring temptation by Satan, according to the Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke, before beginning his public ministry.

In Biblical sense the number 40 signifies the end of an old era and the beginning of a new era, or simply, it implies "change of season." Lent is an invitation to allow our sin and darkness and wounds come to the surface so that we can deal with them and allow them to be healed by the grace of Jesus. During these forty days of Lent, we do not hide from our sinfulness or prevent God speaking to us or healing us during this Lent.

The Church requires us to do some discipline and sacrifices, and fulfill the 3 pillars of Lent, namely prayer, fasting and alms giving. These exercises make us truly united in Christ and thereby realizing our being a Christian.



Our Parish office will be closed on Monday February 19, 2024 in observance of President's Day. We will be open at normal office hours Tuesday February 20, 2024.



During Lent we will once again focus our almsgiving on supporting the work of Hope for Haitians as continue their 18th village. Based in the Rockford diocese, this charity serves the poorest of the poor in Northeast Haiti. Al comienzo de esta Cuaresma Dios quiere renovar con nosotros su Alianza. Como lo hizo con la familia de Noé: después del diluvio, como hemos escuchado en la primera lectura, Dios le dijo: "Yo hago un pacto con vosotros". Esta Alianza era renovación de la primitiva que ya

había hecho Dios con Adán. Ahora era como una re-fundación de la humanidad, después de la catástrofe purificadora del diluvio. Más tarde volverá a sellar su Alianza con Moisés y el pueblo de Israel, tras los años de la esclavitud de Egipto. En verdad, como nos ha invitado a cantar el salmo, "el Señor es bueno y recto", es nuestro "Dios y salvador", "su ternura y misericordia son eternas"

A los contemporáneos de Noé Dios le indicó un signo muy sencillo y fácil de aplicar: cuando vieran el arco iris, que sale después de la tormenta, les invitó a que recordaran su indestructible bondad. A nosotros, los cristianos, es Cristo Jesús, con su Muerte y Resurrección, o sea, con su Pascua, el que mejor nos recuerda este amor de Dios. Ha sido El, Jesús el Salvador, el que "murió por los pecados una vez para siempre, el inocente por los culpables, para conducirnos a Dios. La Alianza ahora es "la Nueva Alianza en la sangre de Cristo". Ha habido algo más que un diluvio o un período de esclavitud: Cristo, nuestro Hermano, se ha entregado hasta la muerte, por solidaridad, y ha restablecido de una vez por todas la alianza entre Dios y la humanidad. Es lo que vamos a celebrar en todo este tiempo de Cuaresma/Pascua.

Fr. Brian Grady, a priest of the Diocese of Rockford, was ordained on May 20, 2000 by Bishop Doran. Fr. Grady attend Mount Saint Mary Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD.

He served as Parochial Vicar at Holy Cross Batavia and Holy Family Rockford. He was Parochial Administrator of the parishes St. Joseph Lena, St. Ann Warren and St. Joseph

Apple River. He was pastor of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Crystal Lake and is currently pastor of St. Rita Rockford.

Fr. Grady also currently serves as the Director of the Office of the Permanent Diaconate for the Diocese of Rockford. In addition, Fr. Grady is a Third Order Carmelite, making his final profession in 2017, and serves as the Spiritual Director for the St. Joseph Lay Carmelite Community that meets as St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church in Crystal Lake.
