



LENTEN REGULATIONS 2024

Once again, the celebration of Christ's Passion and Resurrection draws near. In our preparation for Easter, the Church invites us to observe the penitential and grace — filled season of Lent which commences on February 14, 2024 with the observance of Ash Wednesday. Lent is a time of renewal for the entire Catholic community. It is also a time of spiritual accompaniment as we assist the catechumens and candidates who will be welcomed into communion with the church during the Easter season. In order to assist the faithful of the Diocese of Brooklyn to take full advantage of the Lenten season, our Bishop, Most Reverend Robert Brennan wishes to draw attention to the following:

Abstinence: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent.

<u>Fasting</u>: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

<u>Easter Duty</u>: After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time of the year. By special indult, in the United States, the period of fulfilling this precept has been extended to include the period beginning the First Sunday of Lent (February 18, 2024) to the celebration of Pentecost (May 19, 2024).

Ash Wednesday through Week 1 of Lent

Wednesday ~ February 14: Ash Wednesday <

Behold, now is a very acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation. (2 Cor 6:2)

Thursday ~ February 15

"During Lent we are invited to ascend 'a high mountain' in the company of Jesus and to live a particular experience of spiritual discipline – ascesis – as God's holy people." (Pope Francis, Message for Lent 2023)

Friday ~ February 16

Explore some new meatless recipes and commit to living more simply, accompanying our brothers and sisters who lack material resources.

Saturday ~ February 17

Many who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil will celebrate the Rite of Election tomorrow. Say a prayer for the elect, for those who will be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church, and for all who seek God with a sincere heart.

Sunday ~ February 18: First Sunday of Lent

"This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." (Mark 1:15)

Monday ~ February 19

"Lenten penance is a commitment, sustained by grace, to overcoming our lack of faith and our resistance to following Jesus on the way of the cross." (Pope Francis, Message for Lent 2023)

Tuesday ~ February 20

Examine your conscience before going to bed tonight and make plans to receive the Sacrament of Penance during Lent.

Wednesday ~ February 21

"In the Sacrifice of the Mass the Passion of Christ is made present, and the body handed over for us and the blood poured out for the forgiveness of sins are again offered to God by the Church for the salvation of the whole world." (Order of Penance, no. 2)

Thursday ~ February 22

Today is the Feast of the Chair of Saint Peter the Apostle. Pray for the Holy Father, who sits on the Chair of Saint Peter, that his ministry may help the Church grow in faith.

Friday ~ February 23

Fast from television, streaming, gaming, social media, or some other pleasure and spend the extra time praying or reading the Bible.

Saturday ~ February 24
