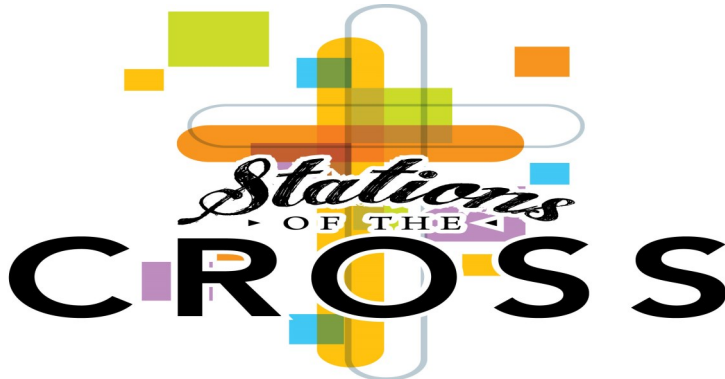

5th Week of Lent

Sunday ~ March 17th: Fifth Sunday of Lent

Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will preserve it for eternal life. (John 12:25)

Monday ~ March 18

"It is in togetherness that we follow Jesus. Together too, as a pilgrim Church in time, we experience the liturgical year and Lent within it, walking alongside those whom the Lord has placed among us as fellow travelers. (Pope Francis, Message for Lent 2023)

Tuesday ~ March 19 - Solemnity of Saint Joseph

As we celebrate Saint Joseph, pray for all fathers, that God may grant eternal rest to those who have died and strengthen the living with love for their families and commitment to their vocation.

Wednesday ~ March 20

"The Sacrament of Penance involves the confession of sins, which proceeds from true knowledge of self before God and from contrition for sins. This inward examination of the heart and outward accusation, however, should be made in the light of God's mercy." (Order of Penance, no. 6b)

Thursday ~ March 21

Pray for a deeper respect for all human life, especially for the most vulnerable: the unborn, the infirm, those with disabilities, those on death row, and the terminally ill.

*** Friday ~ March 22**

Join us at 7:30 as we pray the Stations of the Cross.

On this final Friday of Lent, let your sacrifices unite you with your suffering brothers and sisters and with Jesus' perfect sacrifice on the Cross.

Saturday ~ March 23

If possible, make plans to participate next week in your parish's celebration of the moving liturgies of the Triduum (Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday).

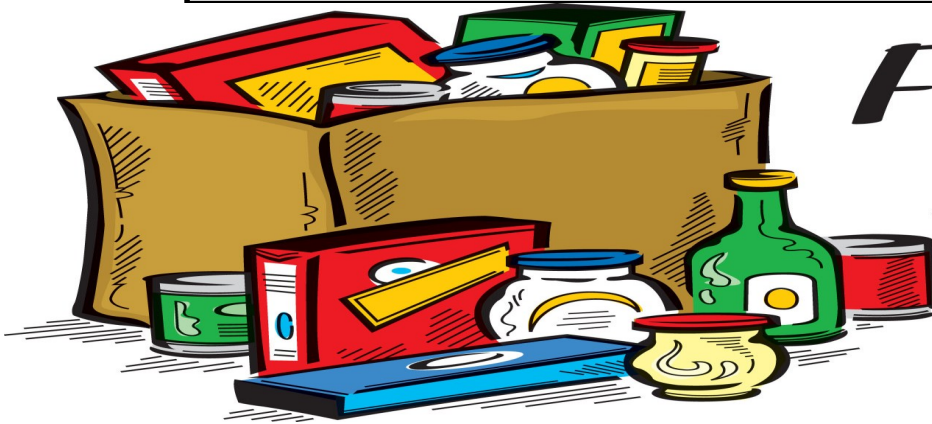

THE LENTEN SEASON 2024



LENTEN REGULATIONS 2024

Once again, the celebration of Christ's Passion and Resurrection draws near. In our preparation for Easter, the Church invites us to observe the penitential and grace – filled season of Lent which commences on February 14, 2024 with the observance of Ash Wednesday. Lent is a time of renewal for the entire Catholic community. It is also a time of spiritual accompaniment as we assist the catechumens and candidates who will be welcomed into communion with the church during the Easter season. In order to assist the faithful of the Diocese of Brooklyn to take full advantage of the Lenten season, our Bishop, Most Reverend Robert Brennan wishes to draw attention to the following:

Abstinence: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

Easter Duty: After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time of the year. By special indult, in the United States, the period of fulfilling this precept has been extended to include the period beginning the First Sunday of Lent (February 18, 2024) to the celebration of Pentecost (May 19, 2024).

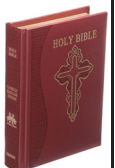
