What are the Lenten Regulations of the Catholic Church?

- **FASTING** is diminishing the quantity of food one takes.
- **ABSTINENCE** is refraining from meat and tasty food, but not reducing its quantity.

Both are efforts that we do in order to purify our senses and better turn our minds and hearts towards God.

On a **day of Fast**, only one full meal is permitted, and two smaller meals which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast.

On a **day of Abstinence**, no meat or tasty food may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

Regulations:

1. The days of both **Fast** and **Abstinence** are **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**.
2. The other **Fridays of Lent** are days of **Abstinence**.
3. The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence is a serious obligation.
4. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection.
5. Outside of Lent, the Fridays of the year are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial.

LLAMADA²⁰²⁵ ANUAL

¿Cuáles son los Reglamentos de la Iglesia Católica para la Cuaresma?

- **AYUNAR** es disminuir la cantidad de comida que uno come.
- **ABSTINENCIA** es abstenerse de comer carne y comidas sabrosas, pero no reducir su cantidad.

Ambos son esfuerzos que hacemos para purificar nuestros sentidos y dirigir nuestras mentes y corazones hacia Dios.

En un **día de Ayuno**, solo se permite una comida completa, y dos comidas más pequeñas que, si se unieran, no excederían la comida principal en cantidad. Aquellos entre las edades de 18 y 59 años están obligados a ayunar.

En un **día de Abstinencia**, no se puede comer carne ni alimentos sabrosos. Aquellos que han alcanzado la edad de 14 años están obligados por la ley de la abstinencia.

Regulaciones:

1. Los dos días de **Ayuno y Abstinencia** son el **Miércoles de Ceniza** y el **Viernes Santo**.
2. Los otros **viernes de Cuaresma** son días de **Abstinencia**.
3. La obligación de observar las leyes de Ayuno y Abstinencia es una obligación seria.
4. Si es posible, el ayuno del Viernes Santo continúa hasta la Vigilia Pascual (en la noche del Sábado Santo) como el "ayuno pascual" para honrar el sufrimiento y la muerte del Señor Jesús, y para prepararnos para compartir más plenamente y celebrar más fácilmente su resurrección.
5. Fuera de la Cuaresma, los viernes del año se designan como días de penitencia, pero cada persona puede sustituir la abstinencia tradicional de la carne por alguna otra práctica de negación voluntaria.
