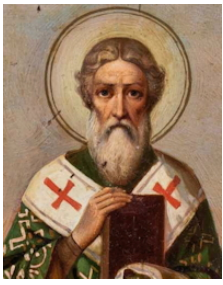

Saint Cyril of Jerusalem, Bishop

St. Cyril became bishop of Jerusalem in 350 A.D. When a famine struck, he spared no expense in providing what he could, and he even sold furniture from the church in order to help the people. Heretics around this time known as the Arians spread false rumors and forced him from his seat and drove him out of Jerusalem. Although cleared of all wrongdoing, it wasn't long until more trouble came. He would be driven into exile two more times by Roman Emperors. Around 380 A.D., he finally came back for the final time and remained as bishop for the rest of his life. He was bishop for 35 years, over half of the time in exile, but he never stopped persevering and caring for the people of God whenever he could. He would write many lectures for catechumens, people wanting to become Catholic and be baptized. **"Your accumulated offenses do not surpass the multitude of God's mercies. Your wounds do not surpass the Great physician's skill."**

Pastor's Reflection

San José, el santo del silencio



San José es el santo del silencio, pero no de cualquier silencio, sino de aquel que tiene un valor, como en la música, en donde el *silencio musical* no es una ausencia de sonido sino un soporte indispensable para que los sonidos de las notas puedan realmente escucharse en toda su belleza. Así, el silencio de san José no es tanto la simple ausencia de palabras, sino el *soporte* indispensable sin el cual toda palabra es estéril. Su silencio tiene un *valor* inigualable, pues es aquel que nace de la **escucha interior** y de la **contemplación del misterio de Dios**.

No es, entonces, la ausencia de palabras que hacen de san José un *santo silencioso*, sino, al contrario, es su deseo de estar en un **continuo diálogo con Dios** en cualquier circunstancia a través de la **contemplación y meditación** y en una **busqueda constante de la voluntad del Padre**.

Detrás del *silencio de palabras* en la vida de san José hay un **coloquio constante de fe y amor** que lo mueve a **actuar aquello que Dios le pide**.

San José, enseñanos y ayudanos a ser hombres y mujeres de *silencio* como tú, **cristianos de pocas palabras y más acción**. Que nuestro *dialogar con Dios* sea el motor de nuestra existencia y que, al saber la voluntad de Dios sobre nosotros, nos levantemos como tú y llevemos a cabo todo lo que Dios nos diga.

Saint Joseph, the Saint of Silence



Saint Joseph is the saint of silence—but not just any silence. It is a silence that has value, like in music, where *musical silence* is not the absence of sound but an indispensable support that allows the notes to truly be heard in all their beauty. In the same way, the silence of Saint Joseph is not simply the absence of words, but the *essential foundation* without which every word becomes sterile. His silence has an incomparable *value*, for it is born from **interior listening and from the contemplation of the mystery of God**. It is not, then, the absence of words that makes Saint Joseph a *silent saint*; rather, it is his desire to remain in **constant dialogue with God** in every circumstance through **contemplation and meditation**, and in a **continual search for the will of the Father**. Behind the *silence of words* in the life of Saint Joseph there is a **constant conversation of faith and love** that moves him to **act according to what God asks of him**.

Saint Joseph, teach us and help us to be men and women of *silence* like you—**Christians of few words and more action**. May our *dialogue with God* be the driving force of our existence, and when we come to know God's will for us, may we rise, like you, and carry out everything that God tells us.

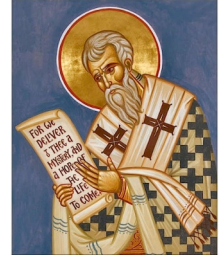

San Cirilo de Jerusalén, Obispo



San Cirilo se convirtió en obispo de Jerusalén en el año 350 d. C. Cuando azotó la hambruna, no escatimó en gastos para proveer lo que pudo, e incluso vendió muebles de la iglesia para ayudar al pueblo. Los herejes de la época, conocidos como los arrianos, difundieron falsos rumores, lo obligaron a abandonar su cargo y lo expulsaron de Jerusalén. Aunque fue absuelto de toda culpa, no tardó en surgir más problemas. Fue exiliado dos veces más por los emperadores romanos. Alrededor del año 380 d. C., finalmente regresó por última vez y permaneció como obispo el resto de su vida. Fue obispo durante 35 años, más de la mitad del tiempo en el exilio, pero nunca dejó de perseverar y cuidar del pueblo de Dios siempre que pudo. Escribió muchas conferencias para los catecúmenos, personas que deseaban convertirse al catolicismo y ser bautizadas. **“Tus ofensas acumuladas no superan la multitud de las misericordias de Dios. Tus heridas no superan la habilidad del Gran Médico.”**
