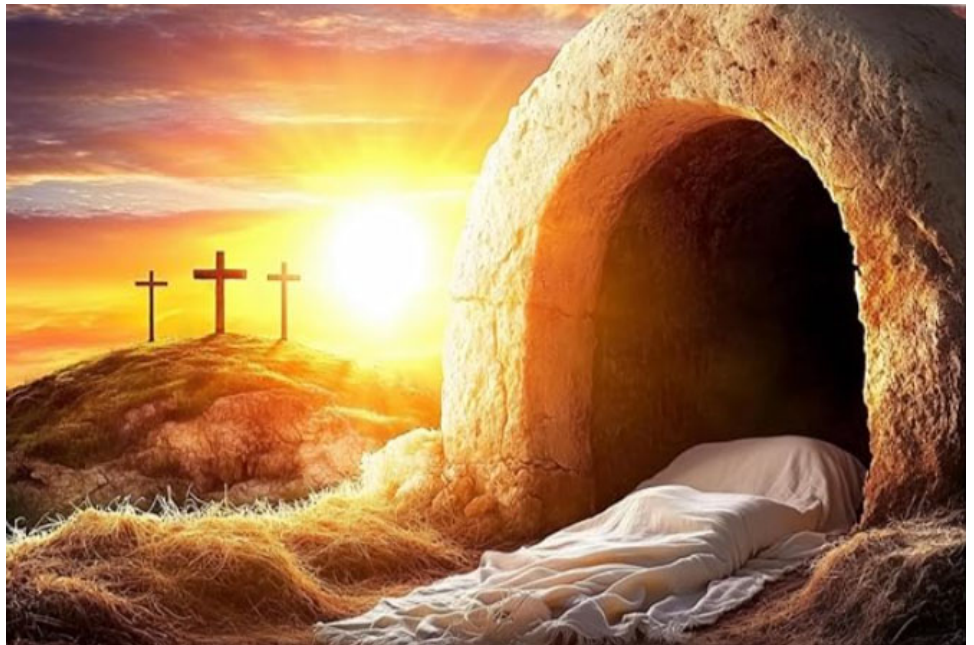

"True worshipers will worship the Father in Spirit and truth; and indeed the Father seeks such people to worship him." John 4:24



Every Thursday, between 7 and 9 pm, come and spend a moment with the Lord truly present in our midst in the **Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist**. It is in **Adoration** that Jesus comes to **meet our hearts** thirsting for love, peace, and happiness.

Way, Truth, Life



In the Old Testament, there is much talk about the paths a person must walk in order to reach God.

“See that you do as the Lord your God has commanded you; do not turn aside to the right or to the left. Walk in all the ways that the Lord your God has commanded you...” (Deuteronomy 5:32–33)

“Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, ‘This is the way; walk in it.’” (Isaiah 30:21)

“Teach me your way, O God, and guide me on a straight path.” (Psalm 27:11)

In this life, in which we are pilgrims, it is important to know how to choose the right path. The decisions that will determine our lives are of great importance—such as choosing a field of study or discerning one’s Christian vocation (marriage, religious life, etc.). Behind every choice lies the search for our happiness.

Jesus tells us that He is this **WAY**. Many times, we have experienced getting lost in a city or some place, searching and trying to find our destination. It often happens when we ask someone to show us the way. Nowadays, most of us use GPS to guide us, but sometimes technology fails; even if it doesn’t lead us in the opposite direction, it may not take us exactly where we intended to go. Jesus, on the other hand, never fails. He not only shows the way—He leads us and accompanies us along it. Even more, He tells us that He Himself is the Way and invites us to follow Him, to walk with Him, through Him, in Him.

Jesus is the **TRUTH** because He is God. And only this truth truly sets us free (John 8:32). Jesus proclaimed the truth and lived it throughout His life. If our search for truth does not lead us to its source and fulfillment, then it is either not truth at all, or it remains only a partial truth that ultimately does not allow us to experience true freedom.

Jesus is the **LIFE**. “I have come that they may have life, and have it in abundance.” (John 10:10). Jesus loved us to the very end, even to the point of giving Himself in sacrifice so that we might have life—that abundant life to which our hearts aspire. And this life is the total gift of Himself, which He has made and continues to make for us in the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, the source of eternal life.

EGO SUM VIA, VERITAS ET VITA

On the ceiling of our church sanctuary we have this phrase from today’s Gospel: *Ego sum Via, Veritas et Vita* (“I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life” Jn 14:6). May God grant us the grace to choose, day after day, to live according to what these words mean.

Camino, Verdad, Vida.



En el Antiguo Testamento, se habla mucho de los caminos por los que el hombre tiene que andar para llegar a Dios.

“Mirad, pues, que hagan como el Señor su Dios les ha mandado; no se aparten a la derecha ni a la izquierda. Anden en todo camino que el Señor su Dios les ha mandado.” (Deuteronomio 5, 32 -33)

“Ya sea que te desvíes a la derecha o a la izquierda, tus oídos percibirán a tus espaldas una voz que te dirá: «Éste es el camino; síguelo.” (Isaías 30, 21)

“Enséñame, oh Dios, tu camino, y guíame por la senda de la rectitud.” (Salmo 27, 11).

En esta vida en la que peregrinamos, es importante saber elegir el camino. Las decisiones que determinaran nuestra vida es un momento de capital importancia como son: elección de la carrera a estudiar, o el discernimiento de la propia vocación cristiana (matrimonio, vida religiosa, etc). Detrás de cada elección se encuentra la búsqueda de nuestra felicidad.

Jesús nos dice que él es este CAMINO. Muchas veces hemos tenido la experiencia de perdernos en la ciudad o en x lugar, buscando e intentando localizar el destino a dónde vamos. Nos ocurre muchas veces al preguntar a alguien que nos indique el camino. Hoy en día, la mayoría usamos el GPS que nos enseña el camino, pero a veces la tecnología falla, y si no te lleva al sentido opuesto tampoco te lleva al sitio exacto que le indicaste... Jesús al contrario nunca falla. Jesús no sólo enseña el camino, sino nos lleva, nos acompaña en el camino. Más aún, nos dice que él mismo es el Camino y nos invita a seguirlo, a caminar con Él, *por él, en Él.*

Jesús es la VERDAD porque Él es Dios. Y solo esta verdad nos hace realmente *libres* (Juan 8, 32). Jesús proclamó la verdad y la vivió en toda su vida. Si nuestra búsqueda de la verdad no nos conduce a su fuente y cúlmen, o no es verdad, o solo se queda en una verdad a medias que al final no nos permite experimentar la autentica libertad.

Jesús es la VIDA. *“Yo he venido para que tengan vida, y para que la tengan en abundancia.”* (Juan 10, 10).

Jesús nos amó hasta el extremo, hasta entregarse en sacrificio para que tengamos vida, esa vida abundante a la cual aspira nuestro corazón. Y esa vida es el don total de sí que ha hecho y y hace ininterrumpidamente por nosotros en los sacramentos, especialmente la Eucaristía. Fuente de vida eterna.

EGO SUUM VIA, VERITAS ET VITA

En el plafón del santuario de nuestra Iglesia tenemos esta sentencia del Evangelio de hoy: Ego suum Via, Veritas et Vita (*“Yo soy el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida” Jn 14, 6*). Que Dios nos conceda la gracia de optar, día tras día, vivir de lo que estas palabras significan.

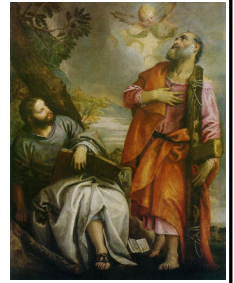
