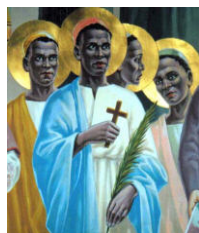

Sts. Charles Lwanga and Companions (June 3)

In 1884, several Catholic missions were already in progress in the country which would later become Uganda. At the time, it was common for the King, at the time King Mwanga, to be promiscuous, even to boys in his court. When his advances were denied on account of them being Christian, he was angered and ordered their execution. Charles Lwanga, a catechuman, was appointed head of the court, but fearing for his life, was baptized earlier than expected in case he was executed for his faith. He took it upon himself to baptize the children in the court who were also catechumens with him. When King Mwanga demanded all in his court to renounce the Christian faith, he and many of the boys he helped baptize refused, and were ordered to be executed. He was burned to death in June 3, 1886, while praying for the conversion of his executioners, saying, **"Please repent, and become a Christian like me."**

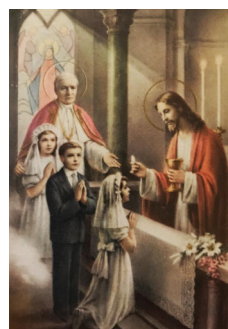

Pastor's Reflection

UN SOLO DIOS pero no solitario

Los cristianos creemos en UN SOLO DIOS, un DIOS UNICO pero **no solitario**. De esta verdad viene entonces también que el hombre no fue creado para estar solo (Gn 2, 18). El misterio de la Trinidad nos enseña la justa convivencia entre la igualdad y la diversidad. Somos iguales en dignidad (personas humanas) pero diversas, diferentes por nuestras características (color de piel, cultura, raza, religion, sexo...).

La familia: primer icono de la Trinidad

La familia esta constituida de personas diversas, comenzando por los esposos (diversidad sexual) y luego diversidad de edades (padres, hijos, hnos mayores-menores); con toda la gama de consecuencias de esta verdad (diversos gustos, sentimientos, actitudes, caracteres). El éxito del matrimonio y la familia, y de toda sociedad humana, tanto social como eclesial, dependerá de la medida con la que esta diversidad sabrá tender a una unidad superior; y esto se logra solo gracias al **amor**. Un amor que se curte en el respeto integral del otro, que colabora en vistas del bien común, que supera los egoismos humanos. **Un amor que se da total y gratuitamente como Dios nos enseña.**

Diversidad en la verdad

Pero, la verdadera unidad, que asume la diversidad del otro, solo se puede dar si somos guiados por **la verdad objetiva**, y no a partir opiniones sin sustento objetivo como el mundo de hoy nos la presenta con la *ideología de genero*. En donde se exige la "igualdad" y la "diversidad" pero fuera del vinculo de la verdad objetiva, lo cual no puede sino llevar a la degradación total del matrimonio, la familia y del mismo ser humano, pues el primado ya no es la **comunión de amor** sino la fusión pasional que acaba por dividir, obstruir, vaciar el corazón. Que este *misterio de la Trinidad Santa* nos ayude a aceptar y amar cada día más plenamente nuestra *diversidad* como Comunidad parroquial, y seamos un reflejo vivo del Amor del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.

ONLY ONE GOD but not Alone

We Christians believe in ONE GOD—a UNIQUE GOD, yet **not a solitary one**. From this truth, it follows that man, too, was not created to be alone (Gen 2:18). The mystery of the Trinity teaches us the proper coexistence between equality and diversity. We are equal in dignity (as human persons) yet diverse—different by virtue of our characteristics (skin color, culture, race, religion, sex, etc.).

The Family: The First Icon of the Trinity

The family is composed of diverse individuals, beginning with the spouses (sexual diversity) and extending to a diversity of ages (parents, children, older and younger siblings); along with the entire spectrum of consequences stemming from this reality (diverse tastes, feelings, attitudes, and temperaments). The success of marriage and the family— and indeed of any human society, whether social or ecclesial— will depend on the extent to which this diversity is able to strive toward a higher unity; and this is achieved solely through **love**. It is a love tempered by integral respect for the other, which collaborates for the sake of the common good and transcends human egoism. **It is a love that gives itself totally and gratuitously, just as God teaches us.**

Diversity in Truth

However, true unity, that which embraces the diversity of the other, can only be realized if we are guided by **objective truth**, rather than by opinions lacking objective foundation, such as those the contemporary world presents to us through *gender ideology*. In this worldview, "equality" and "diversity" are demanded, yet severed from the bond of objective truth—a path that can lead only to the total degradation of marriage, the family, and the human person himself; for the primacy is no longer the **communion of love**, but rather a passionate fusion that ultimately divides, obstructs, and empties the heart. May this *mystery of the Holy Trinity* help us to accept and love our *diversity* as a parish community ever more fully each day, so that we may become a living reflection of the Love of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

San Carlos Lwanga y compañeros (3 de junio)

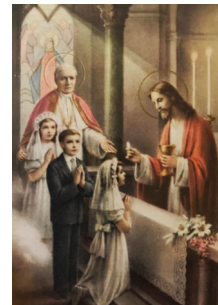


En 1884, varias misiones
católicas ya se encontraban
activas en el territorio que más
tarde se convertiría en Uganda.

En aquella época, era habitual que el rey, —Rey
Mwanga— mantuviera una conducta promiscua,
incluso con los jóvenes de su corte. Cuando sus
insinuaciones eran rechazadas porque fueron
cristianos, el rey se enfurecía y ordenaba su
ejecución. Charles Lwanga, un catecúmeno, fue
nombrado jefe de la corte; sin embargo, recibió el
bautismo antes de lo previsto, previendo la
posibilidad de ser ejecutado a causa de su fe. Él
mismo se encargó de bautizar a los jóvenes de la
corte que también eran catecúmenos. Cuando el
rey Mwanga exigió a todos los miembros de su
corte que renunciaran a la fe cristiana, Carlos y
los jóvenes a los que había ayudado a bautizar se
negaron, por lo que se ordenó su ejecución. Murió
quemado vivo el 3 de junio de 1886, mientras
oraba por la conversión de sus verdugos,
diciendo: **«Por favor, arrepíentanse y háganse
cristianos como yo».**

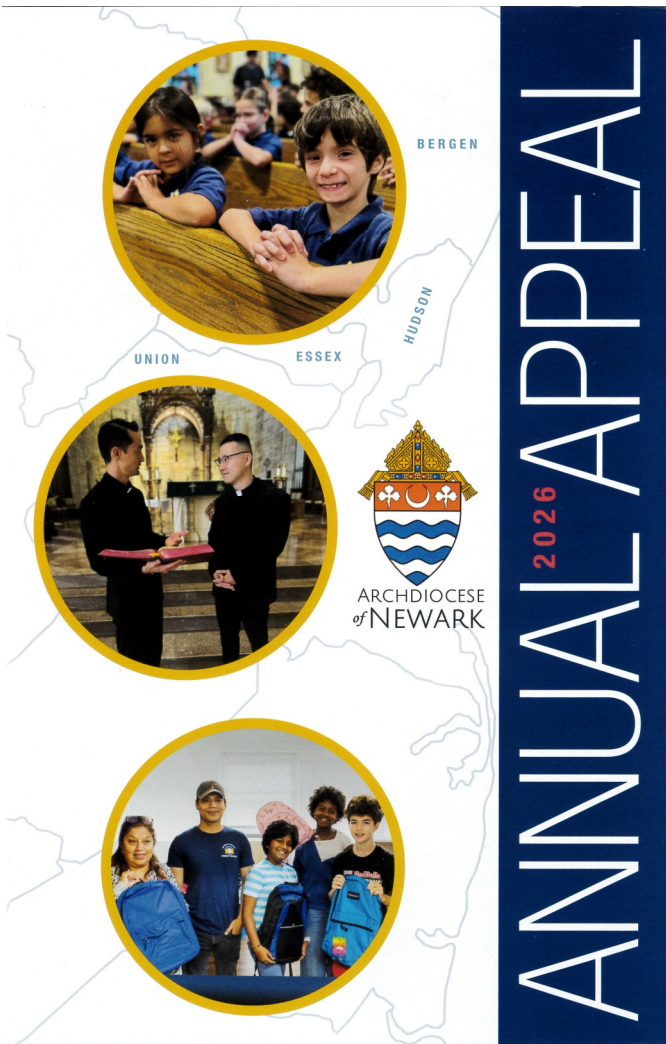
