The Sacrament of Fatherhood



“Reflecting on all this, I bend my knees in the presence of the FATHER, from whom all fatherhood and every family in heaven and on earth derives its name” Eph 3:14-15

“All fatherhood comes from God the Father.” Human fatherhood is a *participation* in and an *extension* of divine fatherhood; for fatherhood to be what it ought to be, it must always and in every respect be guided by its archetype: **God the Father. Human fatherhood is like a sacrament**—that is, it is called to be a tangible **sign of an invisible spiritual reality**: the Fatherhood of God. The vocation of fathers is a call to reflect God’s love for their children through their entire lives.

Sacraments of Life

God the Father is, first and foremost, the Creator—the *source of life*. The primary *sacramental* role of fathers is to **beget and shape a new life day by day—with love, out of love, and to love**—for this is how God creates us and the very purpose of our existence. God the Father *begets* us out of love and leads us with love, giving and surrendering Himself. Fatherhood understood and lived in this way is the only thing that enables children to attain authentic freedom; feeling loved in this manner, they know themselves to be protected and dignified. And although a father must sometimes rebuke, correct, and discipline, he does so always out of love, for the good of his children (cf. Heb 12:5–6).

Being a father means more than just begetting children and providing for the family financially; it means **accompanying, serving, helping, educating, and guiding**. It involves an **effective and affectionate presence** in the lives of one’s children; it means **serving as a reference point for values, a model of dynamic action, and a source of personal bonds and fruitful initiatives**. The goal of **fatherhood** is to help children grow by developing their unique individuality as they seek God the Father’s will for their lives.

Sacraments of the Son

There can be no true father unless one lives as an authentic son (of God). It is becoming increasingly difficult to believe in a God with the face of a Father because there are fewer and fewer men—fathers—who possess the heart of a son. Do you want your children to love, respect, and obey you? Then let them see **you** loving, respecting, and obeying God the Father. Only by maintaining a close, profound, and reverent bond with God the Father can earthly fathers fully realize their paternal responsibility toward their children. Only in this way can we become

sacraments of His Fatherhood. A good father is one who is a good son of God.

Father Joseph Kentenich used to say: *“There is nothing greater or more beautiful for a father than to be able to say to himself: ‘My image has become, for my child, the image of God. Through my actions and my presence, I have striven to imprint the image of God the Father upon my child’s soul, and in this way, my child has received a healthy and true concept of God.’ It is impossible to give one’s child anything more beautiful in life.”*

May this be the legacy that all of you, Christian fathers, seek to leave to your children.

El sacramento de la paternidad



“Pensando en todo esto, doblo las rodillas en presencia del PADRE, del que procede toda paternidad y toda familia en el cielo y en la tierra” Ef 3, 14-15

“**Toda paternidad procede de DIOS-PADRE**”. La paternidad humana es una participación y *prolongación* de la paternidad divina, y para que la paternidad sea lo que debe ser, necesita guiarse siempre y en todo por su prototipo: **DIOS-PADRE**. **La paternidad humana es como un sacramento**, es decir, está llamada a ser un ***signo sensible de una realidad espiritual, invisible*** que es la Paternidad de Dios. La vocación de los papás es el llamado a ser, con toda su vida, un reflejo del amor de Dios para con sus hijos.

Sacramentos de vida

Dios-Padre es en primer lugar Creador, *principio de vida*. La primera sacramentalidad de los papás es aquella de **engendrar y modelar en el día a día una nueva vida con amor, por amor y para amar**, pues es así que Dios nos crea y la finalidad de nuestra existencia. Dios-Padre nos engendra por amor y nos conduce con amor, dándose, entregándose así mismo. La paternidad entendida y vivida así es lo único que puede hacer posible que los hijos alcancen una auténtica libertad, pues sintiéndose así amado se sabe protegido y dignificado. Y aunque al padre le toca a veces reprender, corregir y castigar, lo hace siempre por amor, por el bien de los hijos (cfr Hb 12, 5-6)

Ser padre no solo es engendrar y proveer en lo económico a la familia; ser padre es **acompañar, servir, ayudar, educar, guiar**. Es **presencia efectiva y afectiva** para con los hijos, es **referente de valores, modelo de dinamismo y lazos personales e iniciativas fecundas**. La meta de la paternidad es la de hacer crecer a los hijos desarrollando su originalidad en la búsqueda de la voluntad de Dios-Padre sobre ellos.

Sacramentos del Hijo

No puede haber un verdadero padre si no se vive como un auténtico hijo (de Dios). Cada vez resulta más difícil creer en un Dios con rostro de Padre porque, cada vez, hay menos hombres, padres de familia, con corazón de hijos. ¿Quieres que tus hijos te amen, respeten, obedezcan? Que te vean, pues, a ti amando, respetando y obedeciendo a Dios-Padre. Solo manteniendo un vínculo cercano, profundo, reverente con Dios-Padre, los papás de la tierra pueden lograr el desarrollo pleno de su responsabilidad paternal hacia los hijos. Solo así podemos ser **sacramentos de Su Paternidad**. **Un buen papá es aquel que es un buen hijo de Dios**.

El sacerdote Joseph Kentenich decía: “*No hay nada más grande y hermoso para un padre que este pueda decirse a sí mismo: **mi imagen ha llegado a ser para mi hijo la imagen de Dios. Me he esforzado, a través de mi actuar y de mi presencia, en imprimir en el alma de mi hijo la imagen de Dios-Padre, y, de esta manera, mi hijo ha recibido un sano y verdadero concepto de Dios***”. Es imposible entregarle al hijo algo más hermoso en la vida”.

Que esta sea la herencia que todos ustedes, padres cristianos, busquen dejarle a sus hijos.
