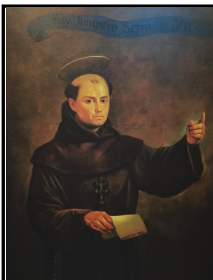

St. Junipero Serra (July 1)

Saint Junípero Serra was a Spanish Franciscan missionary in the 1700's. While establishing missions along the California coast, Serra frequently spoke out against the mistreatment of

Native Americans by Spanish soldiers and settlers. He traveled hundreds of miles to petition colonial authorities for stronger legal protections, insisting that Indigenous people be treated with dignity and justice. His efforts helped secure reforms intended to safeguard Native communities from abuse and exploitation. His desire though was not just social reform (as great as that is) but also to bring others to Christ so that they could experience the life and love of God. He served his community as much as he could until he passed away in 1784. His motto in missionary work and evangelization was always, **"Siempre adelante, nunca atrás! (Always forward, never back!)"**

Details regarding the Annual Campaign for our parish

The Archdiocese of Newark's **Annual Appeal** is the yearly fundraising campaign that supports the Church's essential ministries across the archdiocese's four counties: **Essex, Bergen, Hudson, and Union**. Its goal is to fund programs that are part of our mission as Catholics. While the donation is voluntary, it addresses a crucial aspect of our faith: solidarity and the active sharing of our material resources to meet the diverse needs involved in the Church's evangelization work.

Goal

The fundraising goal for each parish is set by the Archdiocese based on the community's recorded annual finances. For 2026, our goal is **\$23,665**; to date, we have raised only **\$8,435 (from just 32 donors)**. However, there are **717 registered adults** in the parish—not counting a large number of parishioners who are not registered (around 300 more people). If every registered parishioner were to donate just \$33, we would reach the goal.

A portion of the funds can return to the parishes:

For parishes that **reach their initial goal before June 30**, 50% of any amount raised in excess of that goal is refunded to the parish. For example, if we raised \$26,000 against our base goal of \$23,665 before June 30, \$1,167 would be refunded to the parish.

Extended Goal:

Parishes are also offered an *extended goal* (an option our parish has never chosen). For us, this *extended goal* would be **\$30,764.50** this year; if each of the 717 registered parishioners donated **\$42.90**, we would reach that amount. When viewed in realistic terms—based on the number of registered adults (and considering that regular weekly attendance exceeds 800 people)—either goal is attainable. The advantage for the parish in choosing the *higher goal* is a **2% reduction in the "Offertory"** assessment rate (currently 14%). Last year, we paid \$63,499; had we opted for the higher goal, we would have paid only 12% (\$54,425)—a saving of \$9,000—provided the extended goal was reached by June 30.

If parishes do not meet their goal by the mid-year mark (June 30), they have until December 30 to do so, though without the benefit of a rebate on any surplus funds; furthermore, if the goal is not met by that time, the parish's own funds must cover the shortfall. Last year, for instance, there was a deficit of over \$2,000, which the parish had to cover.

Where do the funds from this annual appeal go?

The following are some of the Archdiocesan ministries that receive support thanks to your contributions:

- 1. Proclaiming the Gospel** – Ministries for multi-ethnic communities, family life programs, international missions, and outreach to the deaf community.
- 2. Caring for the poor and vulnerable** – Support for Catholic Charities, Mercy House, hospital and prison ministries, pro-life efforts, and child protection.
- 3. Passing on the faith** – Programs for youth and young adults, faith formation, campus ministries, and Catholic schools.
- 4. Forming priests and supporting retired priests** – Seminarian education, ongoing priestly formation, and medical care for priests.

This invitation to reflect on the reality of our Christian commitment is addressed to those who have not yet made their donation. Those who have already done so need not feel this applies to them. I thank **everyone** wholeheartedly for your generosity, for I am aware that, beyond the Annual Appeal, many already contribute a great deal to the Church and our parish—not only financially, but through the gift of yourselves. **God bless you!**

Detalles relativos a la Campaña Anual para nuestra parroquia

El **Llamado Anual** de la Arquidiócesis de Newark (**Annual Appeal**) es la campaña anual de recaudación de fondos que apoya los ministerios esenciales de la Iglesia en los cuatro condados de la arquidiócesis: **Essex, Bergen, Hudson y Union**. Su objetivo es financiar programas que forman parte de nuestra misión como católicos. Se trata de una donación voluntaria, pero que toca uno de los puntos muy importantes de nuestra fe: la solidaridad y el participar activamente con nuestros bienes materiales en las necesidades diversas que implica la obra evangelizadora en la Iglesia.

Meta

El monto a recaudar por parroquia es dado por la Arquidiócesis basado en las finanzas registradas anualmente de cada comunidad. Para este 2026 nuestra meta es de: **\$23,665**, y hasta este día solo se ha recaudado **\$8,435 (de solo 32 donadores)**. Ahora bien, solo los **adultos registrados** en la parroquia son **717** (sin contar un gran número de parroquianos que no están inscritos (calculo unas 300 personas más), si solo cada uno de los inscritos donara \$33 alcanzaríamos la meta.

Parte de los fondos pueden regresar a las parroquias:

Las parroquias que **antes del 30 de junio** llegan a su meta inicial y si lo donado supera esta, el 50% del surplus se reembolsa a la parroquia. Ejemplo, si de nuestra meta base (\$23, 665) lo recaudado antes del 30 de junio fuera \$26,000, \$1,167 son reembolsados a la parroquia).

Meta ampliada: Se propone también a las parroquias una *meta ampliada* (nuestra parroquia nunca la ha optado). Para nosotros, esta *meta ampliada* seria, este año de **\$30,764.50**; si cada uno de los 717 parroquianos inscritos donara **\$42.90** alcanzamos la suma. Puesto así en números realistas, según los adultos registrados (y tomando en cuenta que los feligreses habituales son más de 800 personas por semana) cualquiera de las dos metas es alcanzable. La ventaja para la parroquia si optáramos por la *meta ampliada* es que se obtiene como beneficio la **reducción del 2% del Ofertory** (pago de la tasa de valoración anual, que en este momento es del 14%. El año pasado pagamos \$63, 499. Si hubiéramos optado por la meta extendida hubiéramos solo pagado el 12% = \$54,425, \$9,000 menos), esto siempre y cuando se llegue a ella antes del 30 de junio.

Si las parroquias no alcanzan su meta para el medio año (30 de junio) tenemos hasta el 30 de diciembre, aunque ya sin ningún beneficio de reembolso si hubiere excedente, y si no llegáramos a la meta para entonces el faltante lo deberá poner las finanzas de la parroquia misma. El año pasado, por ejemplo, faltaron más de dos mil dólares (+ -) y la parroquia debió cubrirlos.

¿A qué se destinan los fondos de esta Colecta anual?:

Estos son algunos de los ministerios Arquidiocesanos que reciben ayuda gracias a sus contribuciones:

1. **Proclamar el Evangelio** – Ministerios para comunidades multiétnicas, programas de vida familiar, misiones internacionales y atención a personas sordas.
2. **Cuidar de los pobres y vulnerables** – Apoyo a Catholic Charities, Mercy House, ministerios en hospitales y penitenciarías, esfuerzos pro-vida y protección de niños.
3. **Transmitir la fe** – Programas para jóvenes y adultos jóvenes, formación en la fe, ministerios universitarios y escuelas católicas.
4. **Formar sacerdotes y apoyar a sacerdotes jubilados** – Educación de seminaristas, formación continua de sacerdotes y atención médica para ellos.

Esta invitación a concientizar esta realidad de nuestro compromiso cristiano es para aquellos que aun no han aportado su donación. A los que ya lo han hecho no tienen porque sentirse aludidos. Y **a todos**, les agradezco de todo corazón, su generosidad, pues soy consciente que, más allá de la Llamada Anual, muchos aportan ya mucho a la Iglesia y a nuestra parroquia, no solo monetariamente sino con el propio don de ustedes mismos. **¡Dios los bendiga!**

San Junípero Serra (1 de julio)

San Junípero Serra fue un misionero franciscano español del siglo XVIII. Mientras establecía misiones a lo largo de la costa de California, Serra alzaba frecuentemente su voz contra el maltrato que los soldados y colonos españoles infligían a los nativos americanos. Recorrió cientos de millas para solicitar a las autoridades coloniales mayores protecciones legales, insistiendo en que los indígenas fueran tratados con dignidad y justicia. Sus esfuerzos contribuyeron a lograr reformas destinadas a proteger a las comunidades nativas del abuso y la explotación. Sin embargo, su anhelo no era solo la reforma social —por muy valiosa que esta fuera—, sino también llevar a otros hacia Cristo para que pudieran experimentar la vida y el amor de Dios. Sirvió a su comunidad incansablemente hasta su fallecimiento en 1784. Su lema en la labor misionera y la evangelización fue siempre: «¡Siempre adelante, nunca atrás!».
