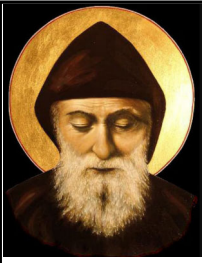

St. Charbel Makhlouf (July 24)

Born Youssef Antoun Makhlouf in the village of Bekaa Kafra, St. Charbel entered the monastery at a young age and later became a hermit, spending the last 23 years of his life in solitude, prayer, and fasting. He would occasionally visit the neighboring town and deliver communion to those who were sick or in need. This may not seem like an impressive life, but it often the simple that go on to do extraordinary things. After his death, numerous miracles were reported through his intercession, leading to his canonization in 1977. According to the Monastery of Saint Maron in Annaya, Lebanon, they have received over 33,000 letters from all over the world attributing a miracle or healing to St. Sharbel. Today, Saint Sharbel is honored worldwide as a powerful intercessor and a model of prayer, and simplicity. **"But as for you, when you pray, go into your inner room, close your door, and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you."** (Mathew 6:6)

Every Thursday, between 7pm and 9 pm, come and spend a moment with the Lord truly present in our midst in the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist. It is in Adoration that Jesus comes to meet our hearts thirsting for love, peace, and happiness.

A Little Is Enough

Today's Gospel presents us with a reflective Jesus, a Jesus who asks Himself a question: "***What shall I compare the Kingdom of God to?***" It is as though He were saying, "*How can I help them understand? How can I make them grasp what truth, freedom, justice, peace, happiness, love, and holiness really are?*" God created us to be happy, to live life to the fullest, and to become holy. This is what the proclamation of the Kingdom of Heaven is all about. The Kingdom is not attained by following an endless list of rules, but by **being docile to the Holy Spirit**. The Kingdom of Heaven asks only that we have hearts willing to be transformed from within through a small act of faith, symbolized by the tiniest of seeds, the mustard seed, or by a little yeast. God asks us to be docile in His hands. He is the Sower who can **accomplish great things with the smallest seed**. That seed is already within us: it is the grace we received at our Baptism. The solution to the crisis of happiness in today's world—even among Christians—is within our reach: **to put our faith into practice**.

When we place ourselves in the hands of the Sower, who knows how to do great things with very little, who can accomplish as much with a mustard seed as with an avocado seed, we begin to understand the mystery of the **Kingdom of God**. Why? Because we choose to believe and to experience the healing, liberating, and transforming power of God's love within us. What could be simpler or smaller than going to Confession regularly, attending Mass and receiving Holy Communion, or striving to understand the meaning of our Baptism, Confirmation, and each of the sacraments? What could be simpler than spending ten minutes before the Blessed Sacrament or reading the Bible for ten minutes each day? If we did these simple things, we would experience the power of the Kingdom of Heaven at work within us—a power that is nothing less than God's infinite and personal love for each one of us. Then our lives would bear abundant fruit in happiness, peace, justice, and holiness.

Con poco basta

El evangelio de hoy nos presenta a un Jesús reflexivo consigo mismo, un Jesús que se hace las preguntas a él mismo: "***¿A qué compararé el Reino de Dios?*** Como si se dijera: ¿cómo les hago comprender? ¿Cómo les hago entender lo que es la *verdad, la libertad, la justicia, la paz, la felicidad, el amor, la santidad?*

Dios nos creó para ser felices, para vivir una vida plena, para ser santos. De esto se trata el anuncio del Reino de los cielos. Este Reino no se obtiene por cumplir un número interminable de normas, sino *siendo dóciles al Espíritu Santo*. El Reino de los cielos reclama solo de nosotros **disponibilidad de corazón** para dejarse transformar desde el interior con un pequeño acto de fe, simbolizado con la semilla más pequeña, como el grano de mostaza, o con el poco de levadura.

Dios nos pide docilidad entre sus manos. Él es el Sembrador que puede hacer de la semilla más ínfima cosas grandiosas; y esa semilla ya la tenemos en nosotros, es la gracia recibida en nuestro bautismo. La solución a la crisis de felicidad en el mundo de hoy y en los propios cristianos está al alcance de nuestra mano:

ejercer la fe.

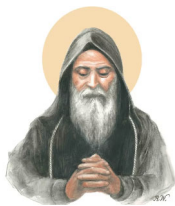
Si nos ponemos en las manos del Sembrador, que **sabe hacer mucho con poco**, que sabe hacer lo mismo con una semilla de mostaza que con la de aguacate, es entonces que comenzaremos a comprender ese Misterio del Reino de Dios por la sencilla razón que **nos decidimos a creer** y a experimentar ese poder sanador, liberador y transformante del amor de Dios en nosotros. ¿Qué de más sencillo y pequeño que confesarnos frecuentemente, ir a misa y comulgar, tratar de comprender lo que significa nuestro bautismo, confirmación y cada uno de los sacramentos? ¿Qué acto más sencillo y pequeño que ir a pasar 10 minutos ante el Santísimo Sacramento, de leer 10 minutos diarios la Biblia? Si hiciéramos esto experimentaríamos el poder del **Reino de los cielos** en nosotros, un poder que es su Amor infinito y personal por cada uno; y entonces nuestra vida portaría mucho fruto en felicidad, paz, justicia, santidad.

San Chárbel Makhoulf (24 de julio)

Nacido como Youssef Antoun Makhoulf en el pueblo de Bekaa Kafra, San Chárbel ingresó al monasterio a temprana edad y más tarde se convirtió en ermitaño, pasando los últimos 23 años de su vida en soledad, oración y ayuno. Ocasionalmente visitaba el pueblo vecino para llevar la comunión a los enfermos o necesitados. Puede que no parezca una vida impresionante, pero a menudo son las personas sencillas quienes realizan obras extraordinarias. Tras su muerte, se reportaron numerosos milagros por su intercesión, lo que condujo a su canonización en 1977. Según el Monasterio de San Marón en Annaya, Líbano, han recibido más de 33.000 cartas de todo el mundo atribuyendo un milagro o una curación a San Chárbel. Hoy en día, San Chárbel es venerado en todo el mundo como un poderoso intercesor y un modelo de oración y sencillez. **«Pero tú, cuando ores, entra en tu habitación, cierra la puerta y ora a tu Padre que está en lo secreto; y tu Padre, que ve lo que se hace en secreto, te recompensará»** (Mateo 6:6).

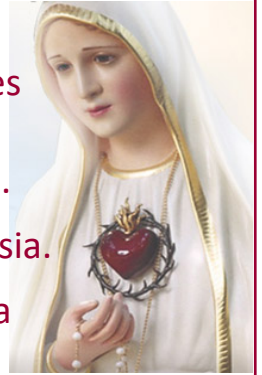

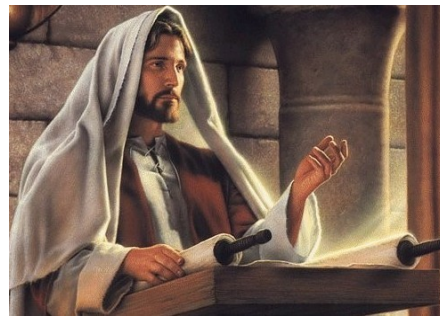
